Dear Parents

Following another successful ski trip last academic year, our school will be returning to the slopes of Italy in March 2019. The ski trip is open to all pupils from Year 7 to Year 10, but Year 10 pupils can only participate in one trip during the year, in order to reduce the impact on their GCSE studies. The ski trip will take place from 10<sup>th</sup> - 17<sup>th</sup> March 2019.

**Please note:** The ski trip will not take place during the half-term break.

We will be skiing in the Aosta Valley, North-Western Italy. No skiing experience is needed, as the pupils will receive four hours of tuition per day. All costs are included, with the exception of ski clothing which can be hired. Snowboarding is also available without any extra charge. We will be using Interski, a UK-based ski travel company with an excellent reputation.

The cost of the trip is **9,500 SR**, which can be paid in three instalments:

Places are limited and will be filled on a first come, first served basis. If a pupil needs to justifiably withdraw from the trip, I will do my best to find a replacement. However, if a replacement cannot be found then monies paid will become strictly **non-refundable**.
