

## Stations of the Cross

One coordinator for each Friday during Lent. This is an easy ministry occurs that only once a year so do not be afraid to volunteer to coordinate a group. Let John know at the office, 333-5544 so he can give you the stations ahead of time and get a notice in the bulletin re: which groups is coordinating any given week.

The Knights of Columbus arrange for the stations for the first Friday of Lent traditionally.

Duties include choosing the “stations booklets” to be used. Becoming familiar enough with them so that there are enough readers to present them properly. It is rather embarrassing and also distracts from the stations, for a man to be reading “I was pregnant when Jesus...” or a woman to be reading the part of Herod, or John the Baptist! *Whoever is in charge also recruits the cross bearer and candle carriers.*

The person also makes sure enough soup will be made and ensures the prayer before meal is read, most likely from the CRS foldout, and assigns a kitchen crew to clean up the kitchen and the hall in time to for all to be upstairs for stations by 7PM.

Tradition has been Knights of Columbus 1<sup>st</sup> week and these various groups each take a week. Pilipino, Native, Samoan, Pastoral Council, and Parish as a whole.

The Liturgy committee or Pastoral Council may coordinate the order.
