On Friday, we finished Catholic Schools Week with a fun in-school field trip with ClubSciKidz. This event was made possible because of donations we received from the Turkey Trot to support field trips.

Our PK3 and PK4 classes learned about the life cycle of butterflies, acting out each step and making a model of the life cycle.







5th-8th grades learned about the properties of matter. They discussed the state of matter, physical and chemical changes, and mixtures and solutions. They then did two experiments where they created changes in matter in different ways by creating two kinds of slime.

Kindergarten-4th grades made rainbow snow! They reviewed what they know about colors (primary, secondary, and mixing colors) and each created 10 new colors using pipettes to mix them. Then they used a polymer to "catch the rainbow" and turned their colors into snow.
