
Also, Council wishes to notify residents of some upcoming changes pertaining to taxation in our municipality.

The due date (December 31st) and graduated discount schedule will continue for 2015. The graduated discount will continue for 2016, however, as of 2017, will be eliminated, generating an estimated additional revenue of \$10,000. This is equal to approximately two days worth of road repair. In 2016, the deadline for property taxes will be June 30, 2016. Penalties will be applied to any outstanding amount on July 1, 2016. Taxes will continue to be due June 30th of each year thereafter.

In an effort to assist with payment options, Council will continue to offer a wide array of payment choices including credit cards, debit cards, post-dated cheques, cash, and pre-authorized payments.




