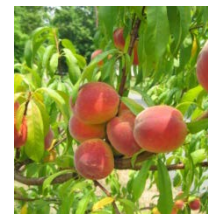


## THE EPISTLE OF JAMES Summary

<b>James 1:2-4</b> Trials test my faith	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Count it all joy</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Enduring faith that is perfect and complete, lacking nothing</li> </ul>
<b>James 1:5-12</b> Lack wisdom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ask w/o doubting</li> <li>Exalt in God when I am in humble circumstances, humble myself before God when I prosper</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>God gives wisdom generously</li> <li>Receive the crown of life promised to those that love Him</li> </ul>
<b>James 1:13-18</b> Tempted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Don't get carried away by my own lusts</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>God is good and gives good gifts, not evil</li> <li>By His will He brought me forth by the word of truth</li> </ul>
<b>James 1:19-21</b> Anger, filthiness, and what remains of wickedness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Receive God's word in humility</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The word is able to save souls</li> </ul>
<b>James 1:22-27</b> Hearer of the word	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Doer of the word</li> <li>Look intently at the law of liberty</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I will be blessed in what I do for others</li> </ul>
<b>James 2:1-13</b> Partiality (favoritism)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Royal Law – You shall love your neighbor as yourself</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Heirs of the kingdom</li> <li>Mercy triumphs over judgment</li> </ul>
<b>James 2:14-26</b> Faith without works	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show my faith by my works</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Faith is perfected</li> <li>I will be called a friend of God</li> <li>Others will benefit</li> </ul>
<b>James 3:1-18</b> Out of control tongue	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Show by my good behavior my deeds in gentleness of wisdom</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wisdom from above</li> <li>Peace</li> </ul>
<b>James 4:1-10</b> Quarrels, conflicts, self-centered motives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be humble and receive God's grace</li> <li>Submit to God, resist the devil, draw near to God, cleanse my hands, purify my heart, be miserable, mourn, and weep...</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>He gives greater grace (greater than all of my sin)</li> <li>God will draw near to me</li> <li>He will lift me up (out of despair)</li> </ul>
<b>James 4:11-12</b> Speaking against one another	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Do not judge</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>God is the only Lawgiver and Judge, able to save and destroy</li> </ul>
<b>James 4:13-17</b> Boasting about our future plans	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Seek God's will for future plans</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Rest in His will</li> </ul>
<b>James 5:1-12</b> Suffering under oppression	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be patient</li> <li>Stand firm</li> <li>Wait for the Lord</li> <li>Do not grumble</li> <li>Let my yes be yes and my no be no</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The coming of the Lord is near</li> <li>The Judge is standing at the door</li> <li>The Lord is full of compassion and is merciful</li> </ul>
<b>James 5:13-18</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Suffering</li> <li>Cheerful</li> <li>Sick</li> <li>Sin</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pray</li> <li>Sing praises</li> <li>Call on elders to pray &amp; anoint with oil in name of the Lord</li> <li>Confess and pray</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The prayer offered in faith will restore the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up</li> <li>Sins will be forgiven</li> <li>Lives will be healed</li> <li>The prayer of a righteous man is powerful and effective</li> </ul>
<b>James 5:19-20</b> Seeing someone stray from the truth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Turn him back</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I will save his soul from death and cover a multitude of sins</li> </ul>
