

Who Do You Say I AM? Part 3

I know this teaching series seems like a lot but it is necessary for what is to come. Let me ask a very harsh question. This question is designed for each of us to know what is in our hearts and to be fully honest with our loving Lord so that He, by His Spirit, can change our hearts and we can be prepared. Say you are in your home church during a Sunday service (or Saturday service) and someone comes in who is clearly under the influence of drugs or alcohol (pick any sinful nature as the visual). How would you respond? Again, this is between you and God because He already knows what is in our hearts (Jeremiah 17:5-10).

Why am I bringing this up? Simple:

Matthew 9:36-38 - But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd. 37 Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few. 38 Therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest."

I encourage you to read all of John 4 and allow Holy Spirit to speak to you. Here is what I am led to highlight for you:

John 4:39-42 - And many of the Samaritans of that city believed in Him because of the word of the woman who testified, "He told me all that I ever did." 40 So when the Samaritans had come to Him, they urged Him to stay with them; and He stayed there two days. 41 And many more believed because of His own word. 42 Then they said to the woman, "Now we believe, not because of what you said, for we ourselves have heard Him and we know that this is indeed the Christ, the Savior of the world."

*And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy." (Revelation 19:10)

*"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End," says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."
(Revelation 1:8)

*"These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands...
(Revelation 2:1b)

*"These things says He who has the sharp two-edged sword...
(Revelation 2:12b)

*"These things says the Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet like fine brass... (Revelation 2:18b)

*"These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars... (Revelation 3:1b)

*"These things says He who is holy, He who is true, "He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens"... (Revelation 3:7b)

*"These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God... (Revelation 3:14b)

*He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. (Colossians 1:15)

*"I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star." (Revelation 22:16)

*Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. (John 11:25)

*But concerning the resurrection of the dead, have you not read what was spoken to you by God, saying, 32 'I am the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob'? God is not the God of the dead, but of the living." (Matthew 22:31-32)

*And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. (Isaiah 9:6b)

*Then Jesus said to them again, "Most assuredly, I say to you, I am the door of the sheep. (John 10:7)

*"I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives His life for the sheep. (John 10:11)

*"I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. (John 15:1)

*And God spoke to Moses and said to him: "I am the Lord. (Exodus 6:2)

*"Hear, O Joshua, the high priest, You and your companions who sit before you, For they are a wondrous sign; For behold, I am bringing forth My Servant the BRANCH. (Zechariah 3:8)

*"For I am the Lord, I do not change; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob. (Malachi 3:6)

*Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. (Matthew 11:29)

*Again the high priest asked Him, saying to Him, "Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?" 62 Jesus said, "I am. And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven." (Mark 14:61b-62)

*For the bread of God is He who comes down from heaven and gives life to the world." (John 6:33)

*And Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life. He who comes to Me shall never hunger, and he who believes in Me shall never thirst. (John 6:35)

*Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life." (John 8:12)

*Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM." (John 8:58)

*And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'" (Exodus 3:14)

*You call Me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am. (John 13:13)

*Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. (John 14:6)

*"I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. (John 15:5)

*In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was in the beginning with God. 3 All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. 4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. 5 And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it. (John 1:1-5)

Revelation 19:11-16 - Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. 12 His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. 13 He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. 14 And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. 15 Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. 16 And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.
