Police Report—Josh Ross (Absent)

Jamie Huval read the police report. As of January 23, 2024, the Arnaudville Police Department responded or self-initiated over 100 calls to service, since the beginning of the year, including a few assistances calls for other agencies.

This month's analytic report shows what the Arnaudville Police Department has done since the beginning of the month. This shows we have had over 155 encounters with members of the public since the beginning of the month. The average response time has been less than 3 minutes, and the average time spent on a call is around 18 minutes.

This month the Arnaudville Police Department has arrested Four (4) individuals for felony level crimes, and another two (2) on misdemeanors. The Officers of the Arnaudville Police Department have also written over thirty-seven (37) citations, with five (5) of them being criminal violations this month, and one search warrant was conducted at Tiger Touchdown #6 formally known as Butches. An administrative hearing to suspend or revoke the liquor and tobacco license of the store is currently pending, and more information will follow next month.

The current state of the department is as follows:

Investigations: We are currently working with other agencies, as close in on the suspects of several ATM thefts in the area.

Staffing: We are currently fully staffed, however we are currently interviewing several applicants, as two (2) officers are currently exploring offers with another agency, paying \$20.50 an hour to start.
