Licensed childcare will begin on a two-week trial period and the following terms and conditions will apply for permanent childcare placement.

PAYMENT TO BE PAID EVERY MONDAY WHEN LEAVING CHILD FOR CARE

A late charge of \$1.00 per minute after 5:30 pm to be paid on the next working day, upon leaving child for care.

VACATIONS

Vacations are the same weekly rate.

Vacations will require a one-month advance notice and will not be more than two weeks per year, unless special circumstances are arranged with parents in advance.

ILLNESS

Childcare will be provided for children with a minor illness such as a cold or cough. Children with a fever, vomiting, and/or diarrhea must be kept home for at least 24 hours starting from detecting symptoms before returning to childcare in order to protect others from contagious diseases and to provide the best care possible for the sick child. Diane's Daycare reserves the rights to make the final decision as to whether a child is well enough to return to childcare after an illness including requiring documentation from the child's healthcare provider.

MEALS

Children are served Breakfast, A.M. Snack, Lunch, and a P.M. Snack.

PARENTS

- Any day a parent chooses to keep their child out of daycare will be paid at the same rate they were in daycare while participating in this contract.
- Provide diapers, wipes and change of clothes.
- No personal toys brought from home.
- Contract will be reviewed, updated and signed annually.

TERMINATION

Four weeks notice is required for termination of childcare by either party. If a parent does not wish to give notice of termination, then two week's rates must be paid in full.
