



RBdigital is a digital audiobook service provided by the Kansas State Library. Patrons can check out 10 audiobooks at a time for 21 days each.

In order to use RBdigital Audiobooks, you must have a Kansas State Library card number. If you don't have one yet, ask our staff to create an account for you.

Getting Started:

- Log in on the Kansas Library website with your card number and birthday (<https://kslib.info/ecard>).
- You will be redirected to a page with several links. Click on “RBdigital Audiobooks Registration” under Digital Book Access Links (<https://statelibraryofks.rbdigital.com/#/register>).
- Fill out the registration form. You can pick your own username and password.
- Start checking out audiobooks with RBdigital!

Borrowing Titles:

- If you're already a registered user, sign in on RBdigital's homepage at <http://statelibraryofks.rbdigital.com/>.
- Browse content by genre or search for a specific title/author.
- Click on the book you want to borrow and, if available, click “Check Out.”
- If a book is unavailable, you may place it on hold. When the title is available, it will automatically be checked out and you should receive a notification email.

How to Listen:

- There are a variety of ways to listen to audiobooks with RBdigital, including mobile apps, computer software, and no software options.
