Policy and Procedure for COVID-19

As per the mandate from the Ohio Office of the Governor, Mike DeWine, as written on April 2, 2020 regarding Stay At Home effective until May 1, 2020:

Permission is granted for leaving the home for essential business. Plain Church meets the criteria according to Point 12 – Essential Business sections: D and E as well as section G

PLAINCHURCH will continue to do the following:

- 1. Regularly Stated Office Hours will be maintained on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday from 9:00am until 12:00pm when person(s) needing counsel, prayer, and or other help and assistance may receive it.
- 2. Regular worship and teaching services on Sunday at 10:30am and Wednesday 6:00pm will be held with live streaming available online. **Beginning Sunday, April 12th at 10:30am** we will offer a Drive In style Sunday outdoor services with people remaining in their cars while watching a live service of worship and preaching simulcast on their car radio.
- 3. Children's ministries including nursery care, children's church and Wednesday KidZone will be suspended through the month of April.
- 4. Those attending indoor service or teaching must adhere to the following:

MAINTAIN social distancing practices

MAINTAIN separated seating from non family members

REFRAIN from physical contact greetings

- 5. Our facility will be cleaned and sanitized in between scheduled services
- 6. Small groups of 10 or less will continue.
- 7. Services, Events, and Activities beyond the regular Sunday and Wednesday services are suspended through the month of April.
