## **CHATUGE WOODS CAMPING RULES**

- 1. Refrain from loud noises and outside activities during the "quiet time" hours of 10 PM to 6 AM. At NO time should outdoor music or TV be at a level that can be heard at other campsites.
- 2. No disruptive noise or behavior is allowed.
- 3. The use of fireworks (including firecrackers and sparklers), firearms and other potentially lethal devices is prohibited in the campground and at the boat ramp.
- 4. Alcohol is permitted only at campsites. Refrain from drunkenness and intoxication while camping.
- 5. Motorized and electric(battery) cart and bicycles, ATV's, etc. are not permitted. See campground manager for medical cart exemption. Small child battery toys may be ridden if accompanied by an adult.
- 6. A 20 MPH speed limit must be observed at all times. No "cruising around" inside the campground.
- 7. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Children over 12 must be under adult supervision.
- 8. Bicycle, skateboard, or scooter riding is prohibited from dusk to dawn.
- 9. The registered camper is responsible for the conduct of his/her visitors.
- 10. A maximum of three vehicles may park at each campsite.
- 11. Only the camping unit registered may be placed at the campsite. "Leasing out" a campsite or camping unit is prohibited.
- 12. Refrigerators and freezers must be kept inside the camping unit.
- 13. Dumping of waste or "gray" water on the ground is not allowed.
- 14. Trash must be bagged and disposed of inside the dumpsters. DO NOT place trash in front of or beside the dumpsters. If the dumpsters are full, place bagged trash by the trees away from dumpsters so that the truck can empty the dumpsters without breaking the bags.
- 15. Do not place Nails or Screws in the trees OR CAMPFIRE rings/pits! Do not place aluminum cans or glass bottles in campfire rings/pits.
- 16. No swings are allowed to be hung from the trees.
- 17. The shoreline is open equally to all campers for water activities, anchoring, etc.
- 18. Do not remove picnic tables from campsites or alter/improve campsites.
- 19. Turn outside faucet off before leaving the campground. Should a camping unit or hose leak water, there may be a charge to the registered camper for the wasted water.
- 20. Under no circumstances shall pets be left unattended anywhere in the campground. Pets that bark in a manner that disrupts the camping enjoyment of others shall not be allowed in the campground.
- 21. Pets are prohibited in the bathhouses.
- 22. No more than 2 pets are to be kept per occupied campsite.
- 23. Persons bringing pets are responsible for removing and disposing of any waste produced by the pet in a timely manner.
- 24. Pets must be kept on a leash (short leash in common areas) or portable fenced area around the camping unit.
- 25. Pets that are aggressive toward people or other pets are not allowed in the campground.
- 26. Camping is at your own risk. Chatuge Woods Campground is not responsible for illness, injury or property damage.
- 27. Chatuge Woods Campground reserves the right to change or add to any rule without notice.
- 28. We ask that when your camping unit is not in use that you turn the a/c unit to off or to a warmer setting.
- 29. Campground management reserves the right to revoke camping privileges should management determine it to be necessary. You may be asked to leave the campground and be given a date and time to remove the camping unit, camping equipment, personal property, etc. Failure to comply may result in the camping unit and all other items being removed at the owner's expense. A refund will not be given if camping privileges are revoked.
- 30. Refunds require a 30 day notice.

- 31. Clear all items from the campsite including anything driven or screwed into the ground at the end of your camping reservation. Any items left behind will be considered abandoned and subject to disposal at your expense.
- 32. After July 4<sup>th</sup>, lake water levels decrease periodically. It is recommended you monitor watercrafts daily to ensure they don't dry dock. Remove all items placed in the water or lakebed at the end of your visit.
- 33. At the end of each open season, the electricity and water are turned off promptly at 12:00 noon. All sites must be cleared and vacated prior to 11:30 AM November 1.
- 34. Make checks and money orders payable to Towns County. Mail them to Chatuge Woods Campground P.O. Box 1044 Hiawassee, GA 30546. Call 706-994-1533 to pay with a credit/debit card.
- 35. Payment in full is due at the time reservations are made. Checks and money orders being mailed in must be received within 10 days from the date a site is reserved. Payment must be received prior to arrival.
- 36. A camper may stay on a campsite no longer than 21 consecutive days.
- 37. Check In is 3:00 PM and Check Out is 11:30 AM.
