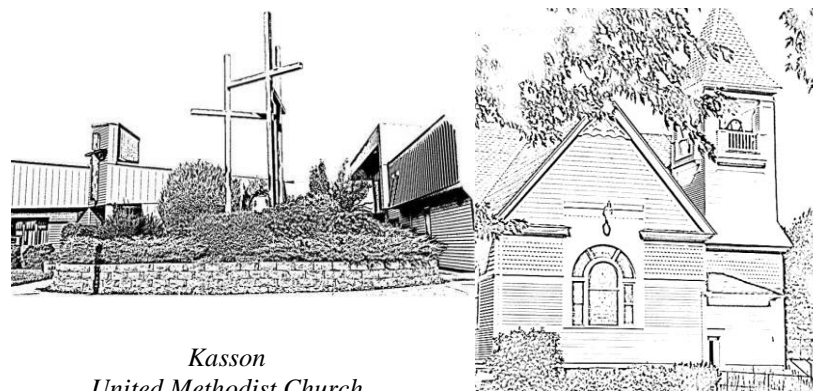
They are registered at Bed, Bath & Beyond- baby registry, Target- baby register or Amazon.com

Questions:

- 1) Our final reading from Ezekiel shares many similarities with our first, but in reverse. What happens here that is the opposite from the beginning of this book?
- 2) What is the purpose of the imagery and prophecy given here? What is the hope that the Lord gives?
- 3) As we close out our time in Ezekiel, what have you taken away from this book? What has the Lord spoken to you through the words of this scripture over the last month, and what will you carry with you going forward?

Memory Verse: Ezra 4:12 "Yet many of the priests and Levites and heads of fathers' households, the old men who had seen the first temple, wept with a loud voice when the foundation of this house was laid before their eyes, while many shouted aloud for joy."

Weekly Challenge: Looking back over the last month, reflect on how the Lord has spoken to you through Ezekiel, and give Him thanks for His word.
