DESCRIPTION: Great looking and performing Browning recurve. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. 2 professionally filled screw holes on the side of the riser (see pic). These holes were filled with matching saw dust and look more like little knots in the wood than a fill. One filled screw hole in the back of the riser 3" below the shelf (probably used to attach a sling) See left pic on page 3. . No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. There are a few blemishes on the riser where it appears some of the wood appears "bleached" as shown in pics. Decal is in fair condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow sold for \$75 in 66, which translates to \$597 in 2020 inflation adjusted dollars.
