General Program Information

The Young Citizenship Award is a \$1,000 scholarship created to honor students who exemplify the qualities of an outstanding citizen. This award recognizes individuals who consistently demonstrate honesty, hard work, fairness, and a genuine commitment to helping others.

Who Should Apply

This scholarship is ideal for students who embody the values of strong character and responsible citizenship. Academic or athletic excellence is *not* required; but applicants should display at least two to three of the qualities listed below:

Citizenship - Students should be dependable and respectful, showing consideration for others, their community, property, and the law.

Attitude - Applicants are expected to be courteous, supportive, and compassionate in their interactions with peers, teachers, and community members.

Academics - A strong candidate strives to reach their personal academic potential, setting meaningful goals and working diligently to achieve them.

Service - Students should demonstrate a willingness to help others selflessly, contributing to their school or community in ways that go above and beyond what is typical for a high school senior.

Leadership - Ideal applicants motivate and guide others, make fair and thoughtful decisions, uphold strong values, and earn the respect of their peers.

Sportsmanship - Candidates show integrity and teamwork in athletic settings, respecting rules, giving their best effort, and prioritizing team success over personal recognition.

Eligibility Requirements

Candidates must be a resident of Haverhill, MA **OR** attend one of the following schools:

Haverhill High School, Whittier Regional Vocational Technical High School, Pentucket Regional High School, or Bradford Christian Academy.my.

Candidates must be eligible to graduate from high school ***this year***, and have plans to attend a college, university, certification/training program, or earn continuing education credits to further their education.

➤ **Citizenship & Attitude** - Describe a time when you demonstrated strong citizenship traits - such as dependability, respect for others, or a willingness to help. How did this experience influence your personal growth?

➤ **Academics** - Explain how you work toward achieving your personal and academic goals. What drives your motivation and commitment?

➤ **Community Service** - Describe a specific moment when you went above and beyond to support your community. What impact did your actions have, and how did this experience shape your understanding of good citizenship?

➤ **Leadership** - Share an example of a time when you demonstrated leadership or teamwork in a school or extracurricular setting. How did your contributions support the success of the group or event?

➤ **Sportsmanship** - Describe a situation in which you displayed sportsmanship. How did you balance your own goals with the needs and success of your team?
