**DAY 1 ★ SATURDAY, MAY 29, 2021 ★ Dallas / Tulsa, OK ★ ( Box Lunch, D )★**

**Motorcoach leaves Dallas (from location TBD) @ 6:30 am for Tulsa, Oklahoma.** En route there will be stops along the way for “necessary breaks” (fresh air, a stretch, refreshments, etc.); related Tulsa stories, movies, and motorcoach games. **Upon arrival in Tulsa** a box lunch will be provided. After lunch, our first stop is a visit to the **John Hope Franklin Reconciliation Park**. A docent lead walking tour memorializes the Tulsa Race Riot, called the worst civic disturbance in American history. The Park also tells the story of African Americans’ role in building Oklahoma and thus begins the long-delayed rendering of the full account of Oklahoma’s history. Next, we will visit the **Tulsa Historical Society and Museum** which has created a traveling exhibit on the history of the Greenwood Area and the 1921 Tulsa Race Massacre for the purpose of educating the community.

## TULSA MASSACRE CENTENNIAL TOUR ★ MAY 29 - JUNE 1, 2021

**DAY 1 ★ SATURDAY, MAY 29, 2021 ★ Dallas / Tulsa, OK ★ (Box Lunch, D) ★ (continued)**

Afterwards, group will check into: **Doubletree By Hilton – Downtown Tulsa, OK**. This evening tour members will enjoy a 3 Course **“Welcome to Tulsa Dinner”** with a choice of beef, pork, chicken, or fish including vegetarian or vegan options.\*

**DAY 2 ★ SUNDAY, MAY 30, 2021 ★ Tulsa, OK ★ (B)★**

*(Anniversary of Dick Rowland on the elevator with Sarah Page)*

After breakfast at the hotel, group will leave for church service at the oldest continuously-operating church in Oklahoma, the historic **Vernon African Methodist Episcopal (AME) Church**. It is the only remaining edifice from the massacre in 1921 and the only black-owned structure from the Historic Black Wall Street era. Tour members can have lunch on their own at nearby restaurants also enjoy shopping at unique shops in the **Greenwood District**. After lunch, the group will leave for a visit of the **Gilcrease Institute of History and Art** for viewing of the special **“Eddie Fay Gates Collection.”** Afterwards, group will continue to the **Philbrook Museum** featuring two special exhibits; “Views of Greenwood - photographs by Don Thompson” and “From the Limitations of Now.” The museum opened in 1939 and has expansive formal gardens. It is a former 1920's villa, "Villa Philbrook", the home of Oklahoma oil pioneer Waite Phillips and his wife Genevieve. Group will return to the hotel and tour members can have **dinner on their own** at nearby restaurants in downtown Tulsa.

**DAY 3 ★ MONDAY, MAY 31, 2021★ Tulsa, OK ★ (B, D)★**

*(Anniversary of Dick Rowland arrested)*

After breakfast at the hotel, group will be joined by a local Tour Guide who is very knowledgeable. Be prepared for a lot of walking today. A full day of sightseeing and activities in Tulsa featuring:

- ~ Booker T. Washington H.S.
- ~ Greenwood Chamber of Commerce
- ~ Tulsa Race Riot Memorial
- ~ Pathway to Hope
- ~ Photo op at the Black Wall St. Mural
- ~ Drive by First Baptist Church (“Up With Trees” – an American Elm that has been growing in Greenwood for nearly 100 years)
- ~ Recently dedicated historic landmarks at Corner of Martin Luther King Blvd & Archer
- ~ Drive by the **Greenwood Rising History Center for Community & Justice for all** (*brand new – opening the summer of 2021*). The museum is based on a narrative museum of expression and experience.
- ~ Mass graves site

In the evening, the group will enjoy a Farewell Dinner in Tulsa.

**Optional:** group members may board the motorcoach at 9:45 pm to travel to the **Candlelight Vigil** in historic Greenwood, a solemn ceremony commemorating the start of the 1921 Tulsa Race Massacre. The vigil will line the streets of Greenwood at 10:30 pm marking the moment the first shots were fired.

**DAY 4★ TUESDAY, JUNE 1, 2021★ Tulsa, OK / Dallas ★ (B, L)★**

*(Anniversary of Greenwood burning to the ground)*

After breakfast at the hotel, with bags packed and ready to go, our motorcoach leaves for a docent lead tour at the **Greenwood Cultural Center**, the keeper of the flame for the Black Wall Street era. A barbeque lunch is included following the tour. After lunch, group will depart for Dallas with an expected arrival time of 6:30 p.m.
