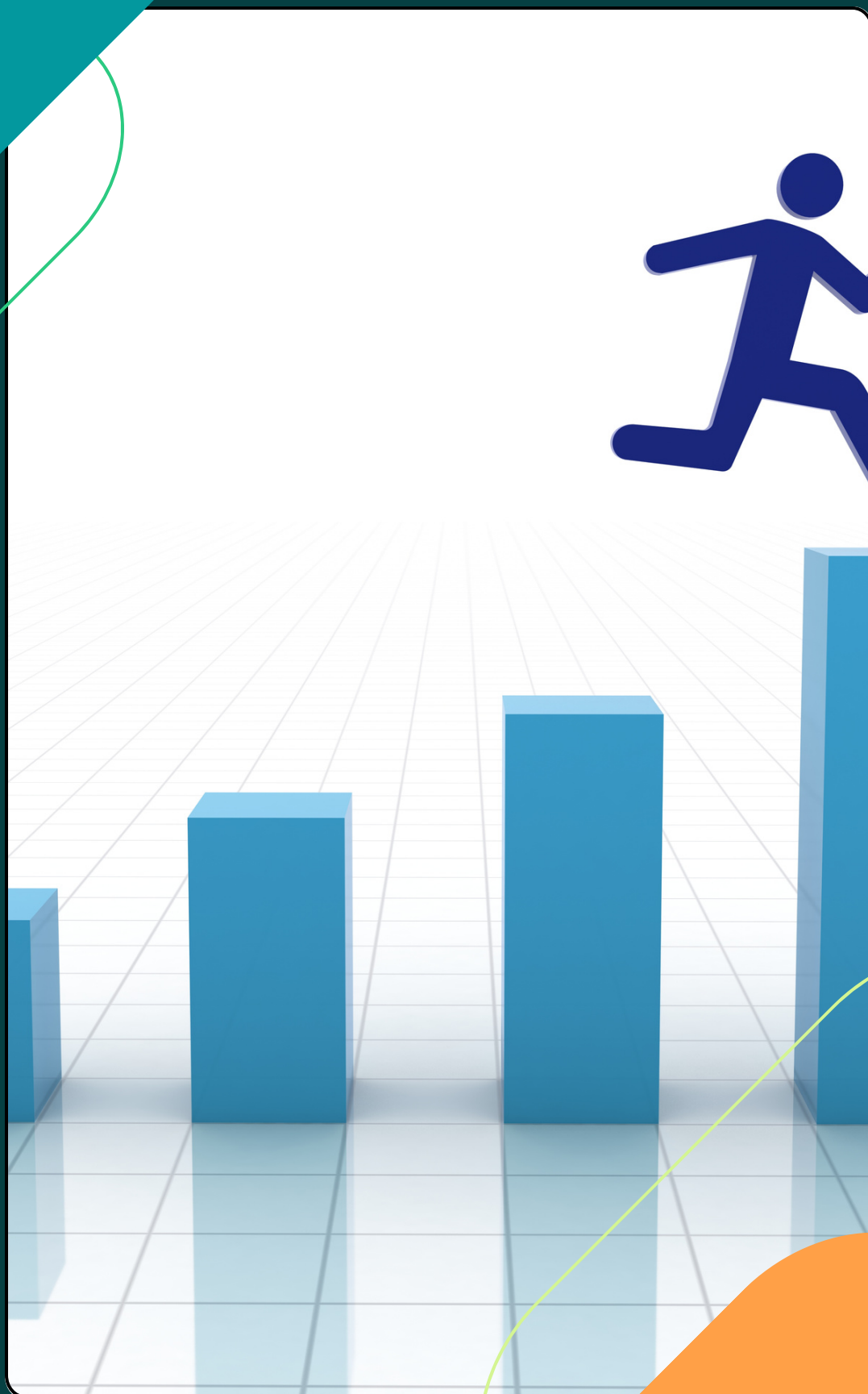

Occupation

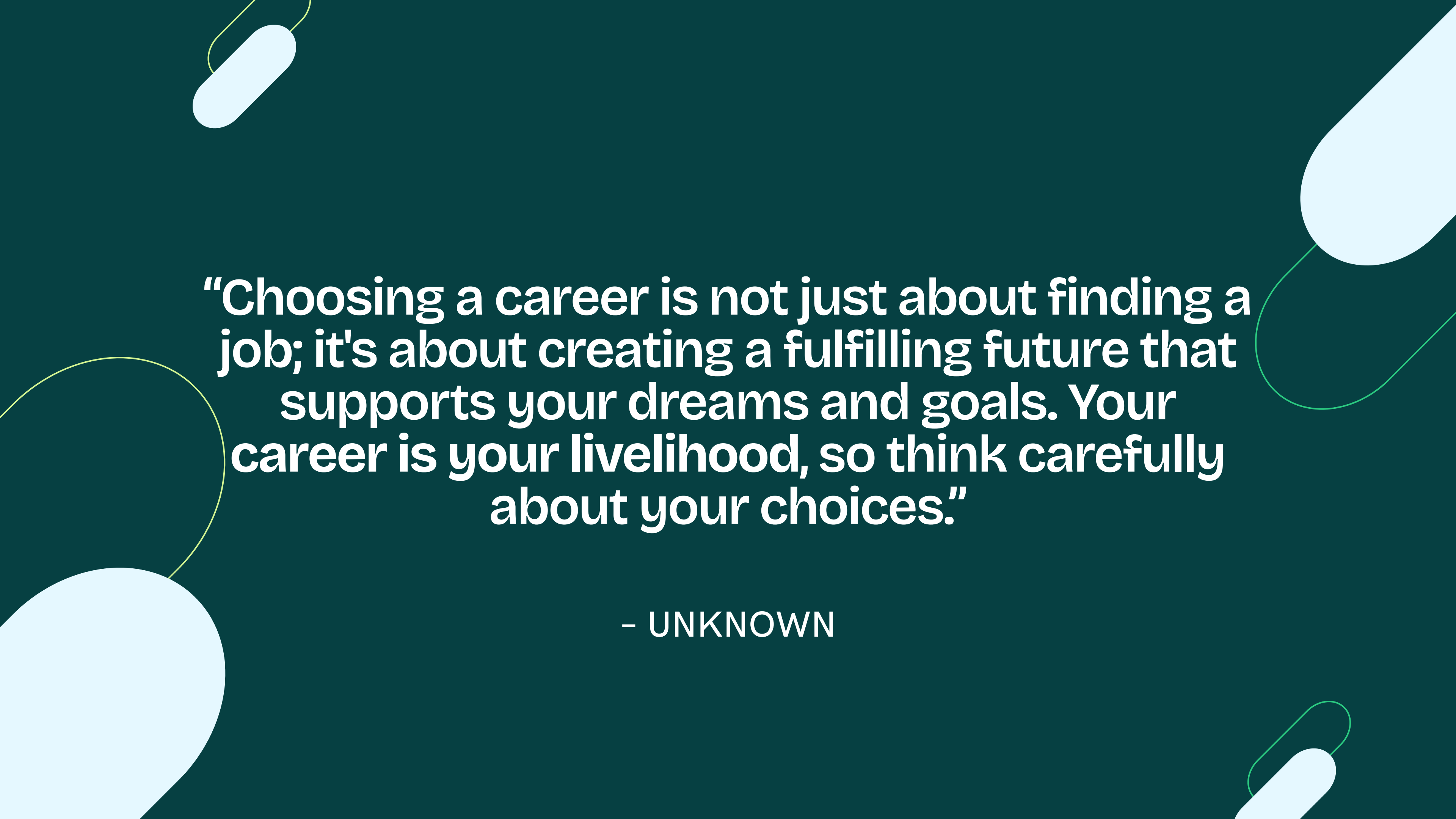
Provides steady earnings with more **skill development** and job opportunities.
