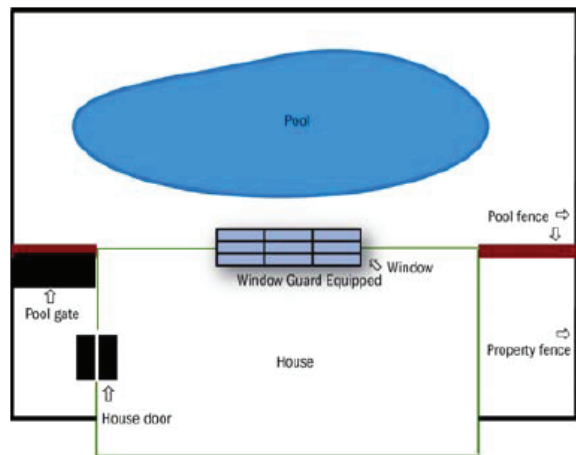


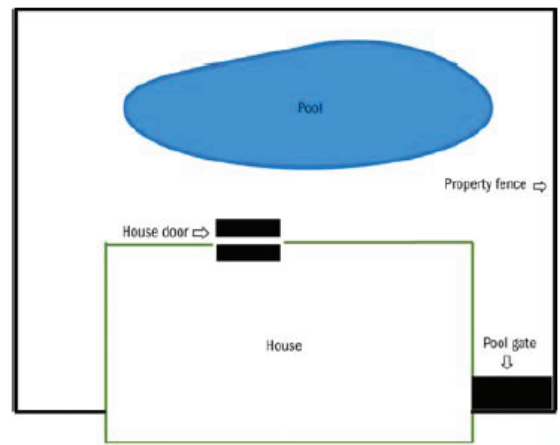

Pool Fencing Diagrams

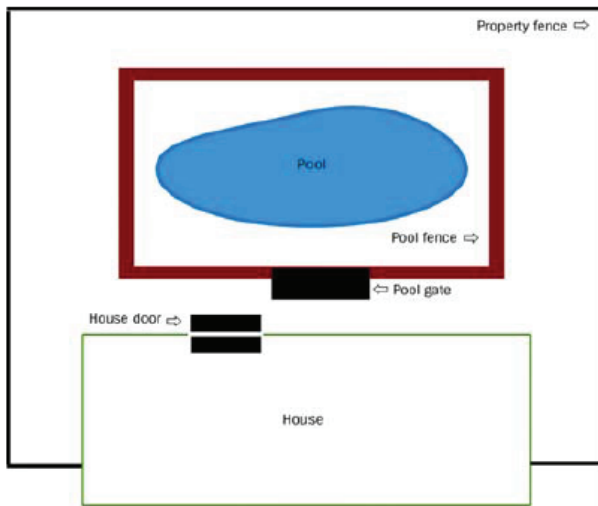
Fencing Layouts



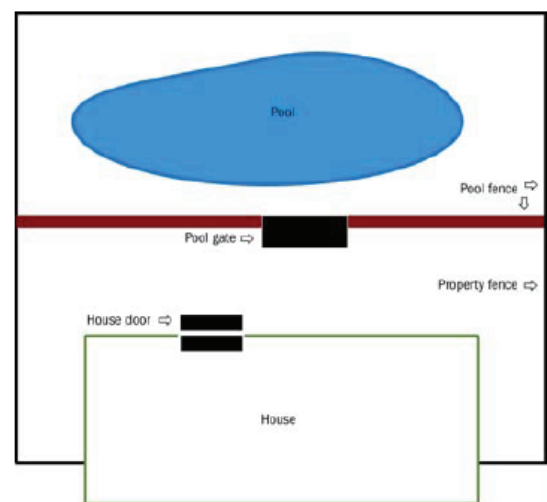
Four-sided Fence Recommended ✓



Property Fence Not Recommended ✗



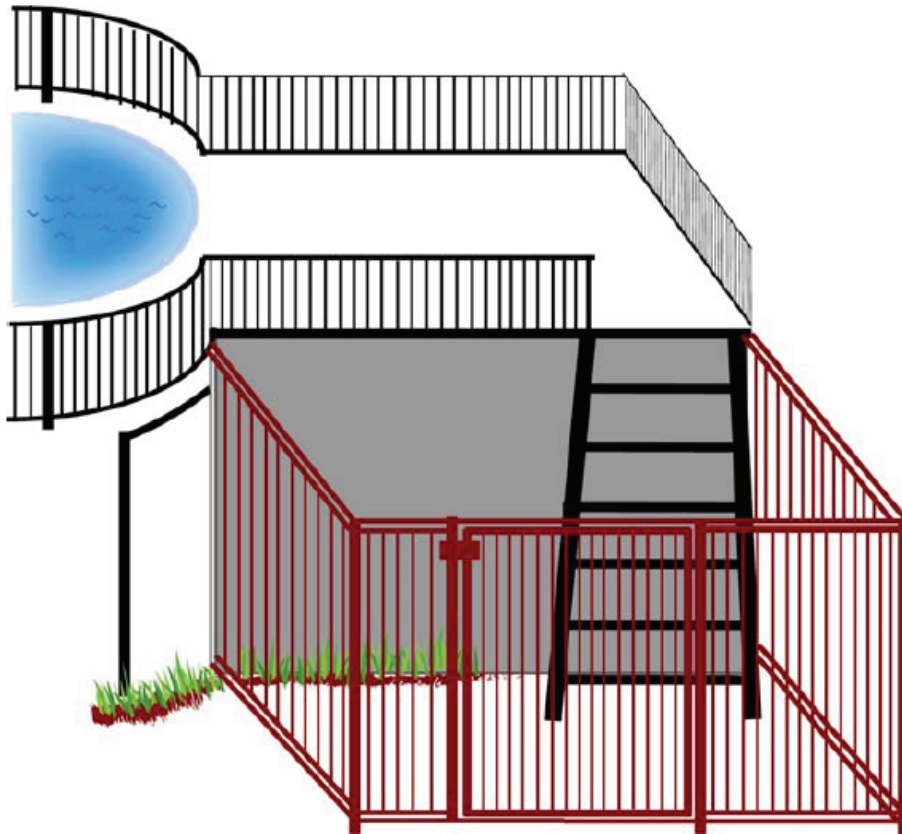
Four-sided Isolation Fence Recommended ✓

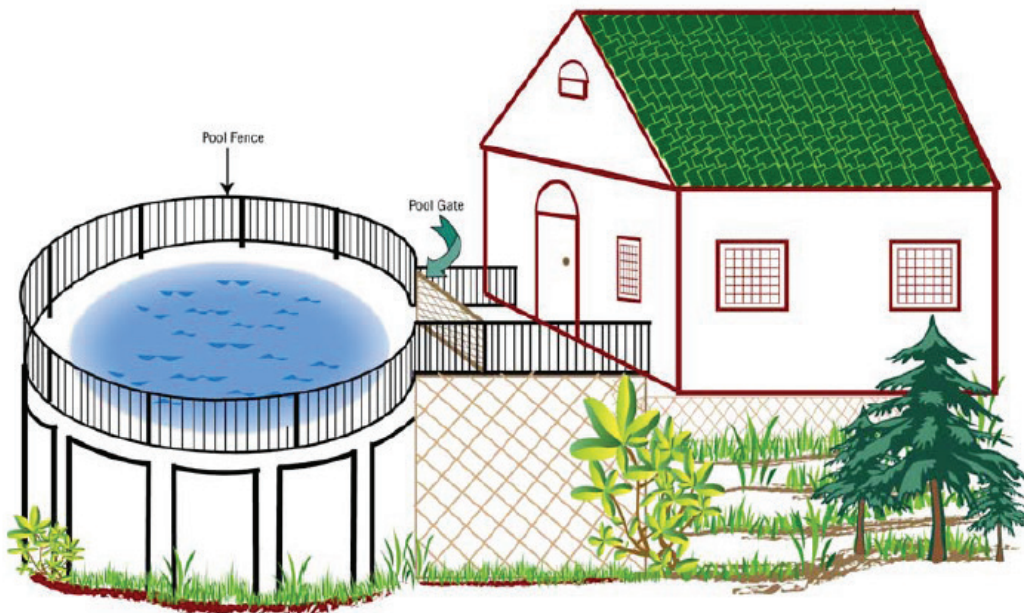
DROWNING PREVENTION - POOL FENCING

48" minimum high Above-ground pool with a properly 48" fenced-gated ladder area – (smooth exterior sides to prevent climbing): **Recommended**



DROWNING PREVENTION - POOL FENCING

Above-ground pool with self-closing and self-latching gate restricting access to the pool from the house – **Recommended**

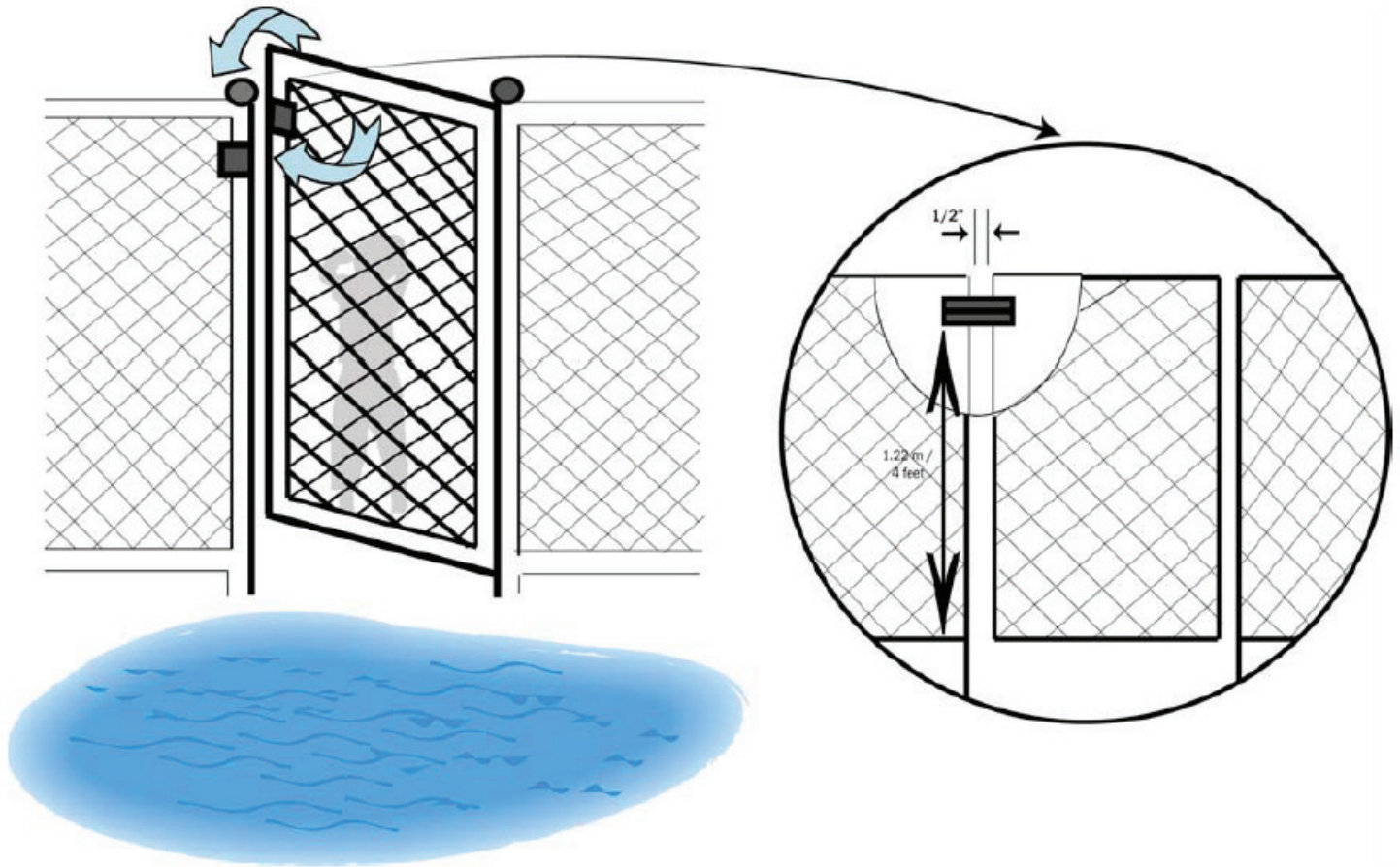


Above-ground pool connected to a deck that is attached to home – **Not Recommended**



DROWNING PREVENTION - POOL FENCING

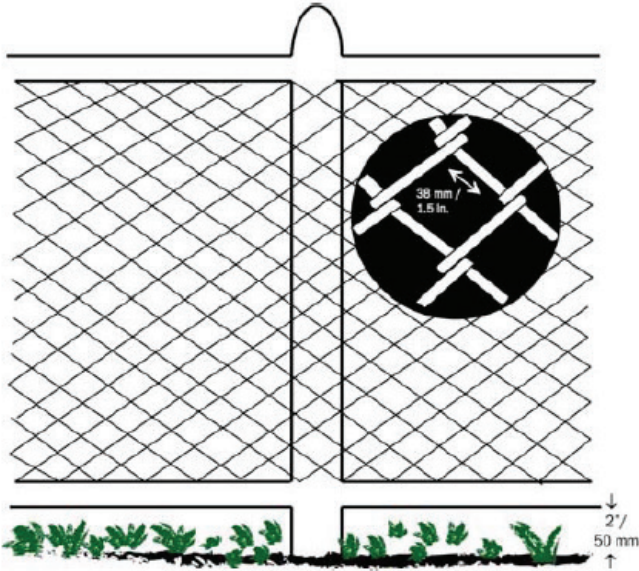
Self-closing and self-latching gate that cannot easily be accessed by young children



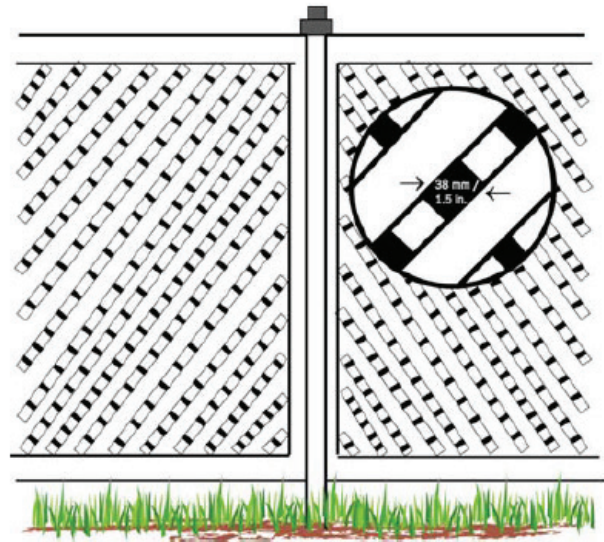

Pool Fencing Types

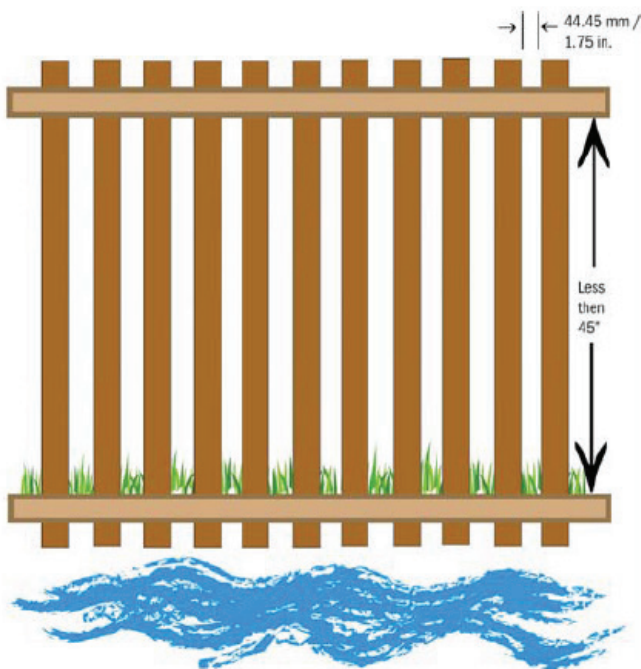
Recommended chain link opening
