#### **STEFANIE DUKE & SR GODIVA**

Schiller Ranch purchased an embryo from Heath Boucher from his great mare, Famous Silk Panties. Schiller bred Famous Silk Panties to PYC Paint Your Wagon. The resulting foal was SR Godiva. As a yearling, Schiller consigned her to the Texas Best Sale where Heath Boucher purchased her. Heath had Paul Martin run her on the racetrack as a 2 yr old, where she won her very first out and ran a SI 87. Heath gave her the winter off and sent her to me in March of her 3 yr old year. I legged her back up and started her on the pattern. We purchased her from Heath around the 1st of May this year.

She has been as easy as they come to train on barrels. I think most anyone could have trained her. She is very kind, wants to please and she's fast!

She did have a couple bad slips at the 1st barrel at a futurity earlier in the year and she lost her confidence at the 1st barrel. She started missing the first and just not committing to it like she always had. My husband kept me from panicking about it and just kept telling me to be patient and wait on her...keep doing my slow work and she'll get her confidence back.

On Godiva I use a Martin BTR saddle, Elliott Bit, BOT, Adequan, Finish First supplement, Equipulmin, and Gastrogard when needed. I feed alfalfa mix, Omolene 200 & Oats.

Her Record: 3rd - BFA Juvenile Futurity 2nd - Future Fortunes Sired Slots 1st - 1st go round Panty Raid Futurity 2nd - Old Fort Days Futurity 1st - 1st go round IBRA Indiana State Finals 5th - IBRA Indiana State Finals 1st - 43rd Annual Indiana Barrel Futurity Lifetime Earnings: \$61,400 The IBRF is the oldest existing (longest running) Futurity in the USA and Canada! Raymond and Vickie Duke and Jeanette Smith (1st women east of the Mississippi to go to the NFR) went to their very first Futurity in Fort Worth, TX in the early 1970's. They came home from that Futurity and decided to put a Futurity on in Indiana, starting the IBRF.

The IBRF entries were up this year in every class. We are excited about that and hope to add more \$\$\$ next year. We also hope to add another major event to the show next year. Hope to announce something on this by January 2018.

My goal for the weekend was to just make some nice, clean, consistent runs and let it fall where it was going to fall. It was a busy weekend with trying to help my in-laws (Raymond & Vickie Duke) and the IBRF committee and also help my husband keep up with my 3 yr old twin boys and ride the horses. I do want to thank Raymond Duke for letting me ride his 5 yr old that weekend. Running his horse helped me get my confidence and get comfortable with my approach to the 1st barrel in this arena. It really helps to make a run or two down the alleyway before I run my only futurity horse. So Thank You Raymond!
