As we move into the fall and winter seasons, the FPWG would ask all cabin owners to begin taking the initial steps to Fire Smart your respective cabin sites. We plan to distribute the Government's FireSmart Homeowner's Manual to all cabin owners when it is available next spring. It has a number of suggestions that can be taken to help protect our properties. In the interim we can do things like removing brush piles and dead trees from our properties. There is ample room at the Transfer Site to accommodate branches, brush, and logs. Dry grass is to be cut short. Logs are to be no more than 3 feet in length.
