# "The Two Surprises of Lordship"

#### Matthew 7:21-29; Luke 6:46-49; Matthew 24.14-15

I. The Lord was surprised at the disobedience of the professing.

**Luke 6:46–47** — "<sup>46</sup> "Why do you call Me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say? <sup>47</sup> "Everyone who comes to Me and hears My words and acts on them, I will show you whom he is like:"

-"How can I be your Lord and you don't obey me?"

### A. The three steps to Lordship (Luke 6:47):

1. Come to Him

Then you are truly submitted to my Lordship.

2. <u>Listen to Him</u>

3. Obey Him

II. The People will be surprised that Jesus does not know them.

Matthew 7:21–23 — "21 "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven will enter. <sup>22</sup> "Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' <sup>23</sup> "And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness.'"

What kind of people are we talking about? – Jesus would say, "Those people who think I know them only because they profess my name."

## A. Three truths from Jesus' teaching about the Kingdom:

- 1. Saying the right words will not get me into His kingdom v21.
- 2. Doing good works will not get me into His kingdom v22.

### -Now that comes to a surprise

- 3. Obeying God's will gets me into His kingdom. -John 3:36
  - a. **-John 3:36** "He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son shall not see life, but

the wrath of God abides on him."

### B. Three Classes of People: Which are we?

- 1. Those who neither call Him "Lord" nor do the things He says.
- 2. Those who call Him "Lord" but do not do the things He says.
- 3. Those who call Him "Lord" and do the things He says.

### C. Building a life of obedience is the wisest decision for eternity.

Matthew 7:24-27 <sup>24</sup> "Therefore everyone who hears these words of Mine, and acts upon them, may be compared to a wise man, who built his house upon the rock. <sup>25</sup> "And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and burst against that house; and yet it did not fall, for it had been founded upon the rock. <sup>26</sup> "And everyone who hears these words of Mine, and does not act upon them, will be like a foolish man, who built his house upon the sand. <sup>27</sup> "And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and burst against that house; and it fell, and great was its fall."

- 1. The one major difference between the wise and foolish man: Obedience to Jesus' words.
- 2. Illustration: Marriage can't survive without faithfulness.

## III. Summary of Jesus' words:

- A. Lordship Law #3 The evidence of loving God and knowing God is obeying God.
- B. "Partial obedience is not obedience at all... it's only convenience."
- C. Wrong Types of "Obedience":
  - 1. Selective obedience I determine when I'll obey.
  - 2. Situational obedience -The situation determines when I'll obey.
