No person having a motorboat in his/charge or under his or her control shall permit same to be operated by another person on Emerald Lake, also known as Hills Pond, in the Town of Hampton, Washington County, New York, with the exception of a motorboat having an electric motor not exceeding one and one-half horsepower.

This Local Law shall in no way be construed to prohibit the operation of any motorboat which has an electric motor not exceeding one and one-half horsepower on Emerald Lake, also known as Hills Pond, in the Town of Hampton Washington County, New York.

Any person who violates any provision of this Local Law may upon conviction be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars (if additional space is needed, please attach sheets of the same size as this and number each)"
