Local Law No. 2 of the year 1976

A local law prohibiting the operation of motorboats on Emerald Lake, also known as Hills Pond, in the Town of Hampton, Washington County, New York, with the exception of motorboats having electric motors not exceeding one and one-half horsepower.

Be it enacted by the TOWN BOARD of the

County of Hampton, New York, as follows:

Section 1.

No person shall operate any motorboat on Emerald Lake, also known as Hills Pond, in the Town of Hampton, Washington County, New York, at any time, with the exception of a motorboat which has an electric motor not exceeding one and one-half horsepower.

Section 2.

No person having a motorboat in his/charge or under his or her control shall permit same to be operated by another person on Emerald Lake, also known as Hills Pond, in the Town of Hampton, Washington County, New York, with the exception of a motorboat having an electric motor not exceeding one and one-half horsepower.

Section 3.

This Local Law shall in no way be construed to prohibit the operation of any motorboat which has an electric motor not exceeding one and one-half horsepower on Emerald Lake, also known as Hills Pond, in the Town of Hampton Washington County, New York.

Section 4.

Any person who violates any provision of this Local Law may upon conviction be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars

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nor more than One hundred (\$100.00) dollars for each violation. In addition, the Town Board may also maintain an action or proceeding in the name of the Town in a court of competent jurisdiction to compel compliance with or to restrain by injunction the violation of this Local Law.

Section 5.

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as required by the Municipal Home Rule Law.
