 - ★ University of Nebraska (Omaha & Lincoln)
 - ★ Iowa Western Community College
- Get help applying for financial aid, independent living funds, ETV funds, and scholarships to assist with paying for school
- Attend LEAP classes, study sessions, career activities and social events
- Get help finding – and keeping – a job that you love
- Participate in financial case management or financial education
- Participate in leadership activities, engagement opportunities, and let your voice be heard!

You might be eligible if you:

- Currently live in Lincoln or Omaha
- If you were in – or currently are in – the foster care system
- Are between the ages of 14 and 24 (at the time of enrollment)
- Are within nine months of high school graduation and on-track to graduate – OR if you have a high school diploma or GED certificate
- Are not currently enrolled in postsecondary education
- Are committed to working with your LEAP team to ensure success!
