The Clean, Cold Clear Challenge – Begin a Carbon Cutting Project

Discussed ahead with teachers to decide how best to implement. Each group or class picks one, two, or three projects. We work with students on start-up, provide information, and get an action plan.

For either option, a visit to the boat can follow the program. Students can each spend up to 20 minutes touring the boat in groups of 12 or less.

All-day or overnight excursions for teacher/student groups on *Amicus II*

New this year! For that special teacher(s) and students who have demonstrated interest in or commitment to climate work. The schedule will be planned with the participants and will include liveboard/sailing lessons and climate work: water temperature and clarity testing, letter-writing, guided discussions on climate and related topics, and goal-setting. All food, overnight gear, and fees included.

Please note: Our fees are based on the actual cost of running programs. The cost to your school will be determined solely by you, your school, and your ability to raise funds. As a non-profit, we raise funds all year long to ensure that schools can participate regardless of how much they can pay. No school will be turned down from lack of funding.

OTHER NOTES

1. Grade and group size vary considerably. We have worked with groups as small as four students and as large as 250 students, K-12. Program content and interaction will vary considerably, depending on your students, your schedule, and your desired priorities. Call for a more detailed discussion about “what works best.”
2. For presentations, a big screen or blank wall is needed. We provide our own props. We provide projector and laptop if needed.
3. We try to be open for “Boat Tours” for several hours a day for informal tours with students and their families if the school cannot officially arrange a visit.
4. At the end of the day, we leave the teacher/contact person with our own “Carbon Footprint Quiz” for students to fill out at the teachers’ discretion at another time. This quiz can be filled out individually by students and then taken home.
5. We request to use your school photocopy machine for the paperwork that we hand out (which we keep to a minimum).
