Primary Uses

- TRICAL TRITICALE is ideally suited for early to late boot forage harvest, for production of premium silage for lactating cows.
- TRICAL TRITICALE is earlier in maturity. This makes a superior forage ration and works well in rotation with silage corn.

Key Attributes

- TRICAL TRITICALE exhibits very dense canopy of long leaves designed to be used in double crop systems that are intend to maximize annual forage production.
- TRICAL TRITICALE has a very high leaf-to-stem ratio and at the mid and late boot stage exhibit a higher nutritional value than most winter wheats.
- TRICAL TRITICALE is very responsive to good fertility and crop management. With the earlier maturity of this variety, early spring management is important. Apply spring fertilizer earlier to push the crop out of dormancy for maximum yield and protein. Ample fertilizer is also important.

- Planted late fall or early spring. Stripe rust, leaf rust, septoria or powdery mildew will have limited negative affect on the growth and quality of this amazing cultivar.
