The Stickman Dark Star Puzzlebox

The Stickman Dark Star Puzzlebox was jointly designed by Shane Hales and Robert Yarger for entry in the IPP 36 design competition. The puzzles were hand crafted by Robert Yarger from becote and wenge woods, with brass corner accents.

This puzzle may be somewhat simple compared to most Stickman designs, requiring a minimum of only 5 steps to access its single hidden compartment.



However, its solution is both elusive and unique, requiring a bit of dexterity along the way. The key to opening requires picturing the internal compartment of the box as a star, with its decorative inlaid disks as planets that orbit it.

There is no limited edition status to these puzzles, but only 2 of them were made for the purposes of the competition.
