Our services are provided for seniors ages 60 and over, Monday through Friday.

Adult Day Care:

Provides relief for families caring for a loved one with dementia or Alzheimer's. This service is available Monday through Thursday from 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM. Lunch and transportation are provided.

Congregate Meals:

A hot lunch served at the Pickaway Senior Center at 11:30 AM on Monday, and at 12:00 noon Tuesday through Friday.

Homemakers:

Assistance with cleaning, laundry and running errands. Clients must meet certain eligibility criteria.

Meals on Wheels:

A hot lunch delivered to your home five days a week.

National Family Caregiver Support Program:

Respite and personal care, financial help with co-pays and medicine, utility bills, home repair. The care recipient must be over 60 years of age.

Supportive Services:

Assistance with Medicare & Medicaid papers, HEAP and Commodities paperwork.

Transportation:

Transportation for medical appointments and grocery shopping.



#### Tips to Strengthen your Emotional Wellness

Over the next couple of months I'll share some tips to help you manage some of the challenges. Watch for more tips next month! Emotional wellness is the ability to successfully handle life's stresses and adapt to change and difficult times. People who are emotionally well, experts say, have fewer negative emotions and can bounce back from difficulties faster. This is called resilience. Let's look at a few tips and strategies to help you strengthen your emotional wellness. Brighten Your Outlook: Remember your good deeds. Think about a good deed that you've done. How did that make you feel? Doing something for someone can make you feel pride, happiness and other positive emotions. Think about one thing you can do now for someone – this may help you feel better too! Forgive yourself. We all make mistakes. It doesn't help to dwell on them. We all have made decisions or done things we regret. Forgive yourself and move on. Let go of past hurts and mistakes. If you need to make amends with someone, do that and move on. Give yourself the grace you would someone else. Spend more time with your friends. Visit the Senior Center. Meet friends outside on a porch and visit. Call each other if you can't visit in person. Try a video call – ask your family to help you set it up – it is easier than you think! Explore your beliefs about the meaning and purpose of life. Your purpose may be connected to a job you had or to family or friends. It may be through your spirituality or religious beliefs. It is unique to everyone. Realize that as you explore your beliefs about life, it may help brighten your outlook as well. Develop healthy physical habits. Start with the basics: move more, get quality sleep, drink more water, and eat more fruits and vegetables. Start with one habit and build on it. If you don't drink enough water, add a glass in the morning & one in the afternoon. Don't move enough? Take a short walk, stretch or exercise. Need more vegetables and fruits?
