Sunflower seeds.** They are getting MREs for lunch and some can afford to buy food more than others, so **Ramen, microwave soups, microwave pastas** and other meal-like foods are good options. **Candy.** M&Ms, Nerds, Laughy Taffy, Jolly Ranchers are all good options. But they're not terribly picky, either, so any candy is fine. **Chewing gum. Hot chocolate.** Since they will be doing gunnery, **baby wipes, razors. CHRISTMAS CARE PACKAGES

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

1. Animal products

All meat products - smoked, cured, vacuum-packed, canned, dried or otherwise -are strictly prohibited by German Customs. This also includes pet food and temperature-sensitive dairy products, such as soft cheeses and eggs, and untreated animal products, including game figurines, furs and bone or wood ornaments.

2. Perishable items

Foods that easily spoil and perishable biological substances, including ready-to-eat meals, wild mushrooms, vegetables and kimchi, are forbidden. Nonperishable food items, such as candy and chocolate are allowed.

3. Plant products

4. Coffee, alcohol & tobacco products

5. Kinder Surprise Eggs

6. Nutritional supplements

7. Prescription medication & recreational drugs

8. Firearms

9. Explosives, aerosols & flammable liquids

10. Counterfeit products

11. Endangered species

12. Items intended for resale or home-based business
