

Ordinance Number 590

An ordinance appropriating certain money's

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Commissioners of the city of Garnett, Kansas.

Section- One. that the sum of *Two Hundred and Fifty Nine* ~~and Fifty~~ *39*/*100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the General Funds of the city treasury to pay the bills allowed against said funds at A regular meeting of said board held on the 2nd day of march 1914. A list of which may be found on page *132* of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on that date.

Section- Two. that the sum of *Three Hundred and Fifty* ~~and~~ *6*/*100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Water works funds to pay the bills allowed against said funds at A regular meeting of said board held on the 2nd day of march 1914. A list of which may be found on page *133* of the Journal of the proceedings of the board on that date.

Section- Three. that the sum of *Sixty Three* ~~and~~ *63*/*100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Street fund to pay the bills allowed against said fund at A regular meeting of said Board held on the 2nd day of march 1914. A list of which may be found on page *132* of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on that date.

Section- Four. that the sum of *One Hundred and Thirty Six* ~~and~~ *96*/*100* Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the Electric Light Funds of the City treasury to pay the bills allowed ^{against said funds} at A regular meeting of said Board held on the 2nd day of march 1914. A list of which may be found on page *133* of the Journal of the proceedings of the Board on that date.

Section Five. that the Mayor and city clerk are hereby authorized and instructed to draw warrants on the city treasurer to pay the bills allowed in sections, One. Two Three. and Four. Of this ordinance.

Section- Six. that this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by the Board of Commissioners and its approval by the Mayor.
