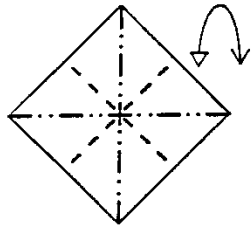


PHOTO STAR by Marcia Joy Miller

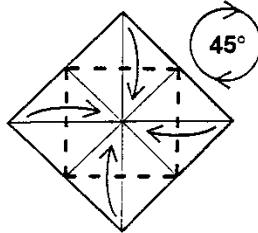
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Use a 25 centimeter (10 inch) square of thin paper.

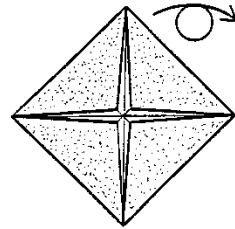
The width of a completed Photo Star is 17.5 centimeters (7 inches).



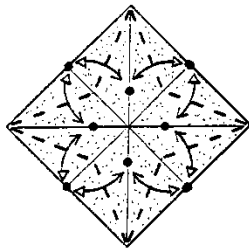
1. Mountain crease the diagonals and valley crease the bisectors of the edges of the square.



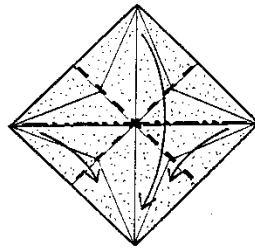
2. Fold each corner to the center. Rotate the model 45° clockwise.



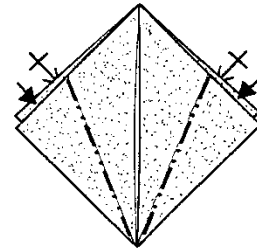
3. Turn the model over side to side.



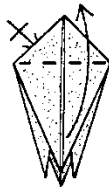
4. Valley crease the angle bisectors. These are partial creases.



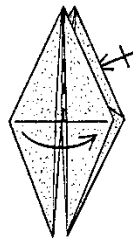
5. Fold a preliminary base.



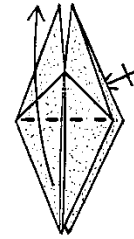
6. Reverse fold on existing creases. Repeat behind.



7. Fold the front flap up. Repeat behind.



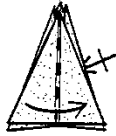
8. Swing the left flap to the right. Repeat behind.



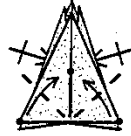
9. Fold the front flap up. Repeat behind.

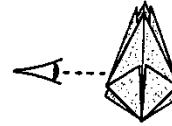

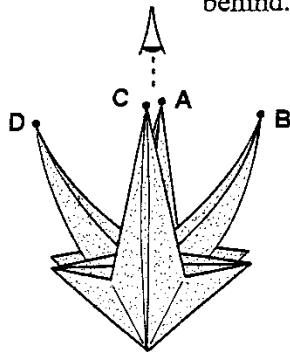
10. Swing the left flap to the right. Repeat behind.



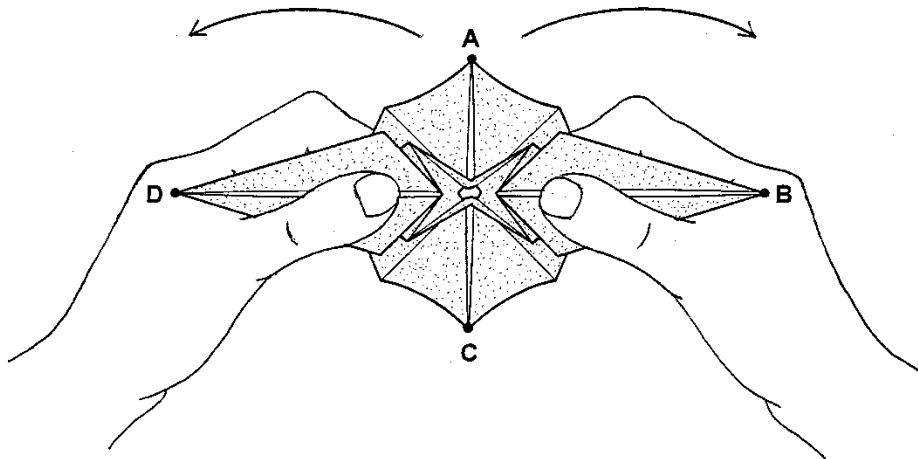
11. Fold the flaps to the center line. Repeat behind.



12. Next view will be from the left side.



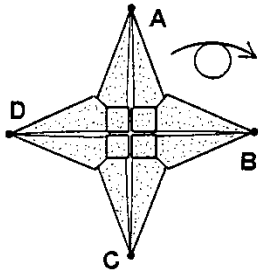
13. Next view will be from above. Note points A, B, C, and D. In the steps that follow be careful to keep the model oriented as illustrated.



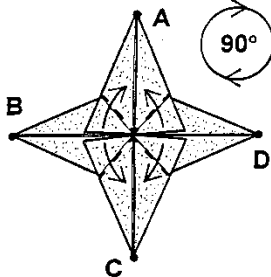
14. Place thumbs deep inside model on each side of the center section. While holding outer side flaps together in pairs with remaining fingers, open the model as if it were a book. Smooth the center and the rest of the model flat.

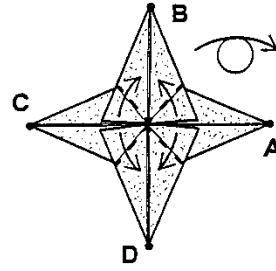

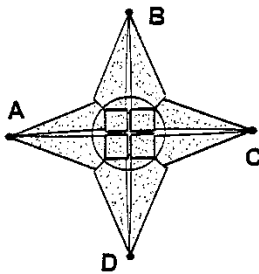
15. Turn the model over side to side.



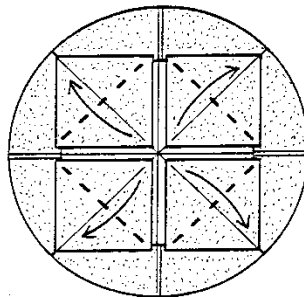
16. Valley fold the four flaps. Crease well. Rotate the model 90° clockwise.



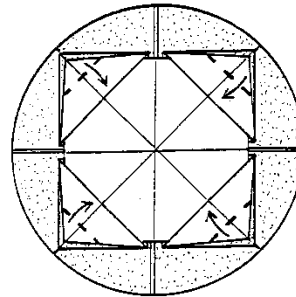
17. Valley fold the four flaps. Crease well. Turn the model over side to side.



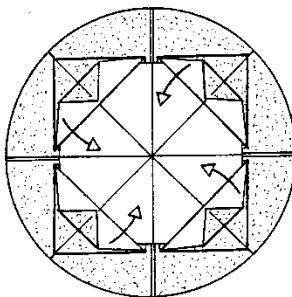
18. Steps 19-23 will show a magnified view of the circled area.



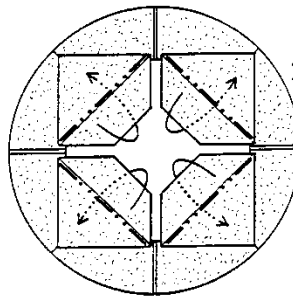
19. Valley fold each of the four center flaps.



20. Fold point of each flap to folded edge.



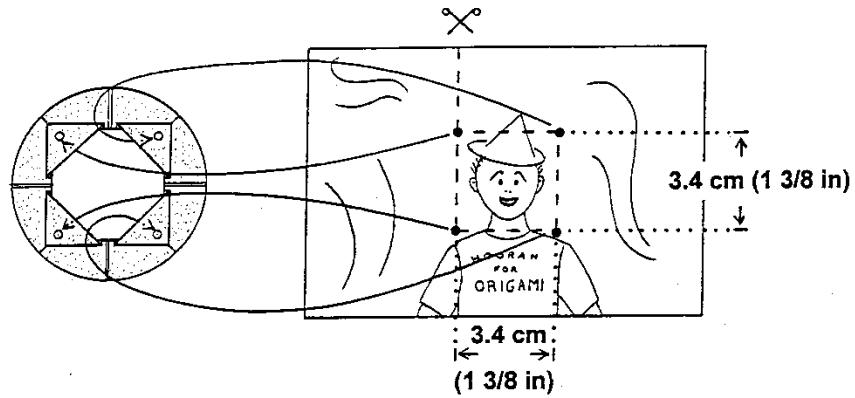
21. Unfold step 19.



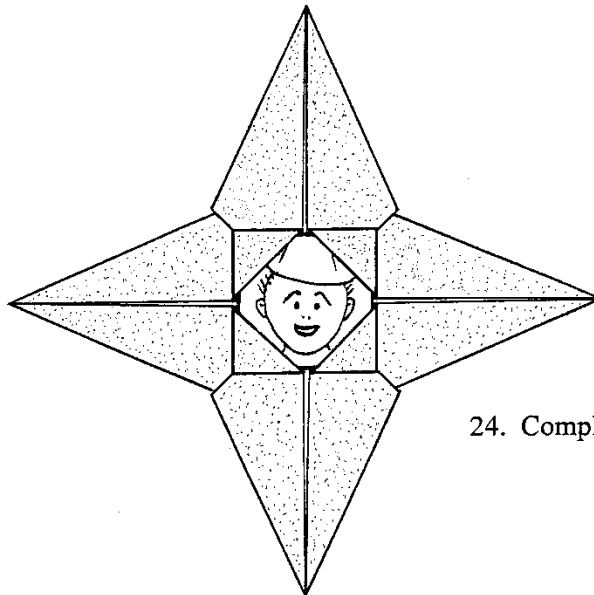
22. Tuck each flap inside corresponding corner pocket.

23. From a photograph, cut a square shaped section that is a little smaller than the frame. For the above example, cut a square that has the dimensions 3.4 x 3.4 centimeters (1 3/8 x 1 3/8 inches). Insert each corner of the square into a pocket of the frame.



24. Completed model.
