1. John, the youngest of the disciples of Jesus, lived to become the bishop over seven churches in what is today, modern Turkey. He was arrested by Roman soldiers and sent to prison for treason against Caesar. The prison was on the Island of \_\_\_\_\_ in the Aegean Sea where God gave him the vision known as Revelation in the Bible. (Rev. 1.9)
2. Shortly after Jesus began his ministry, John the Baptist pointed to him and said, "Look the \_\_\_\_\_ of God, who takes away the sin of the world." (John 1.29)
3. In the throne room of God in Rev. 5, God held the Scroll of Life. An angel cried out, "Who is worthy to open the scroll." The gathered wept because not one of them was worthy. Then a \_\_\_\_\_ came in, "looking as if it had been slain." It took the scroll and all sang a new song, "You are worthy ... to open the seals, because you were slain..." (Rev. 5.1-10)
4. Jesus told a parable about a man who was beaten up and robbed and left on the side of the road to die. A priest and a Levite both passed him by and made sure to walk on the other side of the road and refused to help. Then, Jesus said, a \_\_\_\_\_ came up to him, bandaged his wounds and took him to an inn where he paid for the man to stay a couple days. (Lk 10.33)
5. Jesus invited a tax collector to come with him as one of his disciples. What was his name? (Mt 9.9)
6. In what town did Jesus attend a wedding where he turned water in wine? (John 2.1)
7. In John 3.17 we read, "God did not send Jesus into the world" to do what to the world? Then what is Jesus to do?
8. When asked what are the greatest commandments, Jesus replied, "Love the Lord you God with all your heart and soul and might. And the second is just like it, to love ..." What is the second commandment Jesus said? (Mt 22.39)
9. According to Paul in his letter to the Romans, "the righteousness of God comes through \_\_\_\_\_ in Jesus Christ to all who believe." (Rom 3.22)
