Personnel Committee: Chairman Niece placed himself on this committee in place of Chad Chamberlain. Ms. Napolitani, Ms. O'Connor and Mr. Kiszonak agreed to serve on the Personnel Committee for another year.

Capital Improvements Committee: Chairman Niece asked for clarification on this newly proposed committee. Mr. Shoudt felt 3 members would be sufficient to help plan for the needs of both plants within the next five years. The committee would then come to the Board with its recommendations. Chairman Niece asked for volunteers to serve on the new committee. Ms. Napolitani, Mr. Kiszonak and Mr. Nyland volunteered.

Chairman Niece introduced a resolution for the appointment of the Authority's Public Agency Compliance Officer for 2020. Mr. Shouldt agreed to be the PACO for 2020.

Chairman Niece moved to adopt Resolution #20-08, authorizing the appointment of Mr. Shoudt as the Authority's Public Agency Compliance Officer (PACO) for 2020. Mr. Kiszonak seconded. The motion passed unanimously on a roll call vote.

Lastly, Chairman Niece introduced resolutions to establish a schedule of meeting dates and designation of the official newspapers.

Ms. O'Connor moved, and Mr. Chamberlain seconded to adopt Resolutions #20-09 and #20-10, establishing the schedule of meeting dates for 2020, and for designation of the Authority's official newspapers. All in favor, motion passed.

All regular meetings will be held on the third Tuesday of the month. All regular meetings will start at 7:30 p.m., with the exception of the December 2020 and February 2021 regular meetings, which will immediately follow the Annual Rate Hearing and Reorganization Meeting that will start at 7:30 p.m.

The Board designated the *Star Gazette* as the Authority's official newspaper, and with *The Express Times*, as the two newspapers to receive notices of meetings.

Mr. Scott moved, and Mr. Kiszonak seconded that the Reorganization Meeting be adjourned. All in favor, motion/carried. The meeting was adjourned at 7:51 p.m.
