Confidential Exploratory Outreach

To: (Draft Message to CEO's of Company List attached below)

A limited group of European and global enterprises are exploring the formation of a jointly funded, neutral infrastructure layer for AI systems: a constitutional memory framework that defines and enforces non-negotiable constraints, auditability, and provable limits on advanced AI behaviour.

Objective

This is not ethics advocacy, policy work, or model development. It is **infrastructure** that:

- Reduces systemic AI risk that no single firm can manage alone
- Provides certifiable, auditable guarantees to regulators and customers
- Converts fragmented compliance obligations into a durable trust asset
- Establishes a globally credible baseline for constrained AI deployment

Proposed Structure

The platform would be:

- **Founded and funded** by a limited consortium of enterprises (10-14 participants)
- **Legally domiciled** in Europe (proposed: Switzerland or Netherlands)
- **Technically agnostic:** Model-neutral, vendor-neutral, implementation-neutral
- **Constitutionally governed:** Core rules insulated from commercial capture

Founding participants would not control AI systems through this platform. They would co-own the infrastructure that defines **what AI systems cannot do** and benefit economically as it becomes a global reference standard analogous to SWIFT in banking or ISO in manufacturing.

Initial Exploratory Discussion

We are convening an off-record discussion among CEOs or designated principals to assess:

1. Appetite for shared funding (indicative range: €5-10M per founding member)
2. Acceptable governance boundaries
3. Conditions under which participation would be strategically rational

Executive Summary

The European AI-Governance Alliance is forming to build and operate Constitutional Memory—zero-transmission AI governance infrastructure owned by European enterprises, immune to acquisition, and operational by 2027.

The Elephant in the Room

92% of Fortune 500 employees use ungoverned ChatGPT with company data. EU AI Act enforcement began August 2025 with penalties reaching €35M or 7% of global revenue. Current solutions audit after transmission—Constitutional Memory's BlackVault™ prevents transmission entirely.



Problem: Enterprises need AI governance now, not compliance tools that audit after data leaves



The Gap: Zero infrastructure exists that prevents data transmission while enabling AI use



Urgency: 18-month first-mover window before Big Tech can respond architecturally

Why Alliance vs. Venture-Backed Startup

The Fatal Flaw: Traditional VC path ends in acquisition by Microsoft, Google, or Amazon. European data sovereignty infrastructure would be controlled by the very companies it was meant to provide independence from.

The Alliance Model: Industry-owned consortium (like SWIFT for banking) that cannot be acquired. 10-14 European enterprises collectively fund and control infrastructure in perpetuity.



Investment Structure

Capital Contribution: €5-10M per founding member (10-14 members total = €90M founding capital)

Workforce Participation: Initial pilot deployment to founding member workforces (250K-400K employees), scaling to 5M+ users by Year 5 through commercial customer acquisition

Governance Rights



Guardian Council: One vote per founding member (equal representation)



Strategic Direction: Budget approval, standards development, compliance frameworks



Rotating Chairmanship: 3-year terms, no consecutive terms (shared leadership)



Mission Protection: Not-for-profit structure prevents acquisition



