



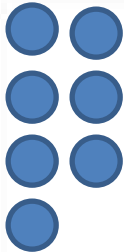
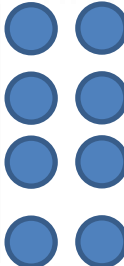
Lesson 10

Standard Algorithm
(Traditional Method)

$$\begin{array}{r} 700.08 \\ - 0.04 \\ \hline 700.04 \end{array}$$

Standard Algorithm (Traditional Method)

$$7.148 - 0.07$$

STEP 1 – LINE UP
THE DECIMALS

STEP 2 – FILL IN THE EMPTY
PLACES WITH ZEROS

STEP 3 – PLACE THE
DECIMAL IN THE ANSWER
BEFORE ADDING or
SUBTRACTING

$$\begin{array}{r} 7.148 \\ - 0.070 \\ \hline 7.078 \end{array}$$
