Letters & Sounds - I know a word - talking about words that rhyme and to produce rhyming words.

Throughout the course of daily activities, encourage the children to think about and play with rhyming words. The adult begins with the prompt '*I know a word that rhymes with cat*' place a hand on your head '*and the word is.....hat*'

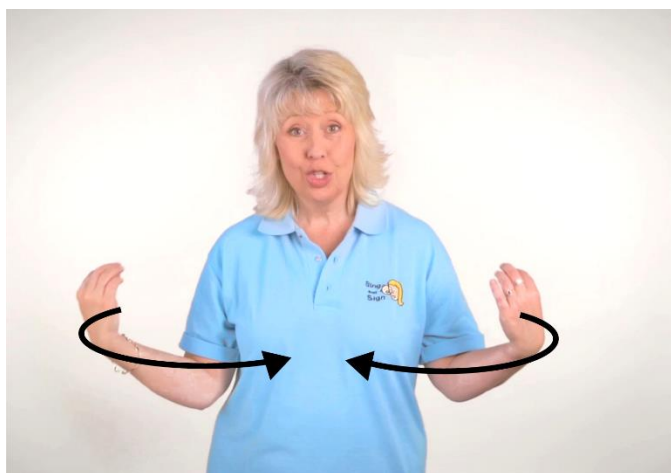
