### DAY 1: May 24, 2019

#### Welcome to Oulu

Upon arrival, the group will be met and transferred for check-in at your lovely local hotel.

Depending on your arrival time, all travelers will gather this afternoon (or following morning) with your national guide and receive further information on the program and today's activities.

### DAY 3: May 26

#### Cultural Exploration

**Please Note:** Breakfast is included daily at your hotel.

The focus of your explorations this morning with your national guide will be to learn about the history and special characteristics of Oulu. Visit some of the key landmarks during a two-hour walking tour from the old monumental center where the first settlers had their homes, onward to market place and the **Oulu Cathedral**. Restored by the architect Carl Ludvig Engel, this Evangelical Lutheran cathedral is the seat of the Diocese of Oulu.

Your national guide will share information today about how the old wooden community has been replaced by today's busy center of traffic and telecommunication. Hear stories about salmon fishing, tar burning, seafaring and life in the magnificent houses of powerful tar merchants and sea captains.

After lunch at a local restaurant, explore the **Koiteli Rapids Nature Area**. This afternoon you will enjoy a lovely walk through the forest, a canoe ride along the river, and wrap up doing a handicraft workshop. Snacks will be provided this afternoon.

This evening take part in a **Lappish cooking class** and dinner. Make a three-course dinner from fresh local ingredients while instructed by a professional and entertaining local chef inside a Lappish Kota.

## DAY 4: May 27

### Professional Exchange

Professional members of the program will interact with local education professionals today including a visit to a local school such as the unique **Pudasjärvi Log Campus**, the world's biggest log school campus. Approximately 850 students go to school here daily. Also spend time today learning about the Finnish education system, the use of ICT in schools, pupil and student welfare, multidisciplinary staff collaboration and school management.

**Journey Mission:** We would like to explore Finland's programs for the preparation of teachers; the approach used in ongoing professional support; and design for career development for the teaching force.

Lunch will be provided this afternoon at a local restaurant.

#### Guest program

*Today accompanying guests will visit a local **reindeer farm**. You will have a chance to get up close and personal with the animals including feeding them and learning some lasso throwing techniques. Enjoy some snacks onsite before having a local lunch and returning to the hotel this afternoon for free time.*

## DAY 5: May 28

### Morning meeting & afternoon service project

Today, continue your professional exchange with visits to a **local school** to observe classroom lessons and continue your dialogue with the faculty. Topics may include priority setting, financial strategies, parental involvement, cultural issues and challenges that remain. The aim is to walk away with a better understanding of what you can do to improve your own strategies for personalized learning for your students.

#### Guest program

*Guests will enjoy some time to shop in Oulu this morning with a local guide. Explore Market Hall to take in the scents and flavors of Finland. Prepare to see many of the city center sights on this walking tour, including the Park Esplandi, Bulevardi Street, a local candy shop, liquor store and traditional Finnish restaurant Kappeli. You will also have a chance to visit the **Oulu Museum of Art**. Opened in 1963, the museum focuses mainly on the art of northern Finnish artists.*

This afternoon the group will give back during a visit to a **local non-profit or other humanitarian organization** dedicated to assisting the local people. *More information will be provided closer to departure. This visit could include a local orphanage, elder care facility, hospital or the Red Cross.*

Lunch will be provided this afternoon with dinner by individual arrangement.

## DAY 6: May 29

### Santa Claus Village

After breakfast, depart for the drive to **Rovaniemi**.

Today you will see Rovaniemi's highlights on a panoramic tour as your guide shares facts about the city, Finnish Lapland's capital. Then, travel through the countryside to the magical Santa Claus Village and come face to face with the great man himself in the Santa Claus Office. Visit the Main Post Office to send Santa Claus stamped greetings, join an Arctic Circle crossing ceremony, and enjoy the shops, elves' workshops, cafés and more.

## DAY 7: May 30

### Fly to Helsinki

Today, you will fly to **Helsinki**. Upon arrival you will be met for your explorations of Helsinki. Start your tour from the Railway Station Square, right next to one of the most beautiful Romantic buildings in Helsinki, the **National Theater**. From there, continue your walk through central Helsinki to get a feel for its vibrant streets, mostly built in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Then, follow the main shopping street, **Aleksanterinkatu**, towards the city's main square, Senate Square. At the central point of the square is the magnificent **Helsinki Cathedral**, built in 1852 when Finland was part of the Russian Empire. Lunch will be provided at a local restaurant.

Continue towards the **Katajanokka Peninsula**, stopping at the Uspenskii Cathedral, a beautiful Orthodox cathedral atop a hill. Go up the hill and to the terrace of the cathedral for pretty views over Helsinki. Explore **Market Square** (Kauppatori), where you can find souvenirs and taste local specialties. After a walk through the district of **Töölö**, visit the unique Rock Church, carved within a rocky hill, and afterwards have a short city bus trip to the park and monument dedicated to the most famous Finnish composer, **Jean Sibelius**.

Check into your local hotel later today where dinner is on your own this evening.

## DAY 8: May 31

### Professional Program

Today the group will wrap up professional interaction with visits hosted by **Finnish government officials** or other **education leaders** to discuss educational policy and government regulations in Finland as it compares to the United States and other countries. Visit a **local school** to observe a classroom and wrap up your discussions with their teachers and faculty. Continue talks of mutual interest and share information about the U.S. education system.

### Guest program

*Guests will spend the day visiting Porvoo with a local guide. Discover the delightful town of Porvoo on a private tour from Helsinki, with an expert local guide beside you. Venture east to this medieval town, Finland's second oldest, and learn about its 14th-century origins and the people who shaped it as you explore. Take a walking tour through the cobbled Old Town, and admire the 15th-century cathedral, Old Town Hall, and traditional, red-painted store houses along the riverside. Before returning to Helsinki, enjoy free time to stroll, relax and perhaps buy souvenirs at the quaint craft shops. Lunch will be provided today.*

Enjoy a farewell dinner this evening.
