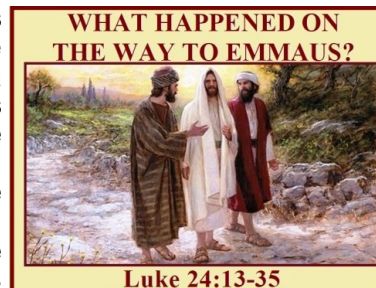

THE EASTER SEASON: The Easter season is celebrated during the seven weeks from Easter to Pentecost. These fifty days of Easter are celebrated as one great Feast Day known as “the Great Sunday” (*Saint Athanasius*). Through the entire Easter season Christians sing the triumphant “Alleluia”, rejoicing in the hope of the resurrection.

In today's Gospel, we see Jesus appearing to his disciples after his resurrection. While in their midst, he interprets the Scriptures and shares a meal with them. This account reminds us of the Church's celebration of the Eucharist. Through the ages, at each Eucharistic liturgy, Christians have come to recognize the Risen Christ in their midst as the Scriptures are proclaimed and the Eucharistic meal is shared. What we celebrate during the Easter season – the Paschal sacrifice of Christ – his dying and rising – is present to us in each Mass, with its saving power.



APRIL 25 - FEAST OF SAINT MARK, EVANGELIST: John Mark, known simply as Mark, was a member of the first Christian community in Jerusalem and he is the author of the earliest and shortest Gospel. His mother, Mary, owned a house in Jerusalem, which the Christians used as a place of prayer during Peter's imprisonment under Herod Agrippa I (Acts 12.12). When Paul and Barnabas returned to Antioch in Syria from their visit to Jerusalem, they took Mark back with them. Later they brought him along as their assistant on a missionary journey. After this journey, Mark returned to Jerusalem. In Christian art Mark is often depicted with a winged lion. He is a patron of notaries, of Egypt and Venice.

April 21 - Memorial of Saint Anselm, Bishop, Doctor: Anselm lived from 1033 to 1109. At age 27, he became a monk, eventually becoming prior and abbot of the monastery where he lived. His fame lies in his role as theologian and philosopher. His spirituality greatly influenced the Church and, in his concern for the oppressed, he was one of the first opponents of the slave trade. He was made a Doctor of the Church in 1720.

April 23 - Memorial of Saint George, Martyr: George was killed for his faith at Lydda in Palestine at the beginning of the fourth century. During the reign of Edward III (14th century), he was made patron of the kingdom of Britain; he is also patron of the Boy Scouts. During the Middle Ages, he was a popular patron of knights, soldiers and crusaders who adopted "St. George's Arms", a red cross on a white background. The red cross appears on the modern Union Jack.

April 23 - Memorial of Saint Adalbert, Bishop, Martyr: Born in Bohemia (Czech Republic) around 956, Adalbert was consecrated Bishop of Prague in 963. However, the task proved too onerous for him because of fierce political opposition, and he withdrew to a Benedictine Abbey in Rome. He engaged in several very successful preaching missions to Poland, Prussia, Hungary and Russia. Known as the "Apostle to the Slavs", he was martyred near Gdansk on April 23, 997.

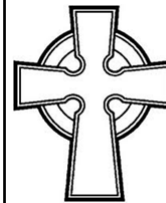
