Weapons of Spiritual Warfare

**All scriptures are from the New American Standard Bible unless otherwise stated.

***Hebrews 13:8** “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.”

***John 14:12** “...and greater works than these he **will** do; because I go to the Father.”

***Psalm 23:5** prepares a table **in the presence of my enemies**; anoints head with oil

***2 Corinthians 10:3-5** weapons of our warfare not of the flesh, are divinely powerful, take every thought captive to the obedience of Christ

- **Praise** – **2 Chronicles 5:13b-14** when they lifted up their voice and praised the LORD, glory of the LORD filled the house of God
 - ***Psalm 34:1** His praise continually be in my mouth.”
 - ***Acts 16:25-26** Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God
 - ***2 Chronicles 20:21** people began singing and praising, the Lord set ambushes against enemy
- **Standing in the gap** – **Ezekiel 22:30** build up the wall and stand in the gap before Me ”
 - ***Isaiah 58:12** you will be called the repairer of the breach
 - ***2 Chronicles 30:18b-20** Hezekiah prays for people
- **Raise a HALLELUJAH**
 - ***Revelation 19:1, 6(NIV)** **Let the enemy hear you roar!!**
- **Name of Jesus** – **Philippians 2:10** “so that at the name of Jesus every knee will bow
 - ***Luke 10:17** even the demons are subject to the name of Jesus
- **Word of God** – **Hebrews 4:12** Word of God is living and active
 - ***Ephesians 6:17** “...,and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.”
- **Holy Spirit** – **2 Timothy 1:7** God has given us a spirit of power and love and discipline.”
 - ***Acts 1:8** will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you
 - ***1 John 4:4** greater is He who is in you than he who is in the world
- **Prayer** – **Philippians 4:6-7** in everything by prayer...peace of God will guard hearts and minds in Christ Jesus
 - ***Colossians 4:2** Devote yourselves to prayer...
 - ***Ephesians 6:18** pray at all times in the Spirit
 - ***Acts 16:25-26** Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God
- **Thanksgiving** - **Philippians 4:6** in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let requests be made known to God.”
- **Fasting** –
 - *Fasting is giving up food (or something else) for a period of time in order to focus your thoughts on God.
 - ***2 Chronicles 20:3-4** Jehoshaphat proclaims a fast throughout all Judah.
 - ***Isaiah 58:6-7** the fast that God chooses

****Romans 8:37** “But in all these things we **overwhelmingly conquer** (to be more than a conqueror) through Him who loved us.

➤ *Word from the Lord (July 31, 2019)*
