Advanced entries close August 18, 2017 at 5pm, at the secretary's home. If entry limits are not reached, day-of-trial entries will be accepted from 8 am to 8:30 am on Saturday and Sunday or until limits are reached. Refunds will be available for entries withdrawn prior to closing. Refunds for bitches in season will be given, minus a \$5.00 per trial administrative fee, if a veterinarian certificate is presented to the trial secretary prior to the start of judging.

Entries must be complete. Entries will not be accepted without a signature and/or correct fees. All entry forms must include the waiver on the back of the form. Express mail entries must include a signature permitting them to be left at the Event Secretary's address without a recipient signature.

START TIMES/ RUNNING ORDER:

Judge's briefing on both Saturday and Sunday will be at 8:45 AM.
Running order will be as follows:
(First round is trial 1, second round is trial 2)
Saturday: AGI, AGI, AGIII, AGIII, AGII, AGII, AGI
Sunday: AGII, AGII, AGIII, AGIII, AGI, AGI

Rosettes will be awarded for High In Trial, High Combined, and High Scoring Junior. Flat ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th places. New Title rosettes will be awarded for those teams achieving these accomplishments.

Site Information: The building will open at 7:30 am. The trial is indoors, on a fully matted single ring approximately 40' by 120' in size. Crating space is limited in the building. Please stack crates when possible. Ex-pens are not allowed. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the entire area clean. Pick up after your dogs. Please wipe up all spills. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dogs will be excused from this trial and no entry fees will be refunded.

Food will be available on site.

DIRECTIONS TO WWCDC

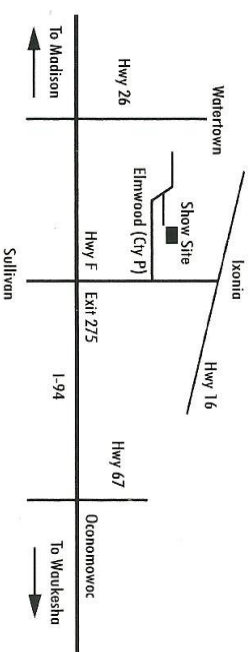
