1430 KEYCARD

The 4NT bid is Keycard only after agreeing on a suit.

The Keycards



The King of our trump suit

1430 Keycard RESPONSES

5 ... = 1 or 4

 $5 \Leftrightarrow = 3 \text{ or } 0$

5 = 2 w/o Q

5 = 2 Q

* The Q of trump is NOT a keycard.

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RESPONSES

* 4 of new suit shows 2 of top 3 honors



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1430 KEYCARD

THE QUEEN ASK

If partner responds 5 Hearts or 5 Spades to our keycard ask, we have perfect information about the Queen of trumps.

However, what if partner responds with 5 Clubs or 5
Diamonds? If we still need to know about the Queen of trump to make our decision, we have a way to ask. So after the responses below, the next available bid of a suit (that is not the trump suit) will ask for the Queen of Trumps.

$$5 \Leftrightarrow 5 \Leftrightarrow = Q \text{ ask}$$

**If hearts is the trump suit, and the keycard response is 5D, 5H is NOT the Queen ask. 5S would be the Queen ask in this case. Note: You would not bid 5S in this situation unless you were looking for Grand Slam

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CONTROL BIDS

Only after we have established a fit and a game force.

BASIC

The bid of a new suit, after the above conditions are met, shows 1st round control of the suit bid.

*1st round control would be an Ace or a Void

EXPERT

The bid of a new suit, after the above conditions are met, shows 1st or 2nd round control of the suit bid.

*2nd round control would be a King or a singleton

<u>WHAT IS 4NT?</u>

The difference between Keycard and Quantitative.

It's Keycard

When both sides are aware of a fit in a suit.

Directly after an opening suit bid or rebid.

It's Quantitative

When the partnership has not established a fit in a suit.

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After partner responds with a major to Stayman, the bid of the other major at the 3+ level will show a slam try in the suit opener bid.
