

Lower Elementary Supply List 2022-2023

So that all classroom and individual student supplies are ready on the first day your child comes to school, we kindly ask that you bring all items to our Parent Orientation Night: Monday, August 22, 2022, at 5:00 PM.

Individual Student Items- All Students

<u>Please label these individual items</u> with your child's name in permanent marker. These items will remain at school throughout the year:

Rain boots (1 pair)

1 Raincoat **or** Rain suit (Please choose only one to send.)

1 refillable water bottle with a **closeable sipper or straw spout**, 16 to 18 oz size - bottles larger than this size are discouraged (**This bottle should be able to be opened by your child.**)

Small toiletry bag filled with the following items:

toothbrush

toothpaste

- hairbrush or comb
- nail clippers
- any other personal item your child uses on a frequent basis, such as a small bottle of lotion, eye drops, itch cream, sunscreen (in stick or cream form-no sprays, please), or bug repellant

Complete change of seasonally appropriate clothes packed **in a plastic ziploc bag** labelled with your child's name:

- Amare shirt
- Solid-colored pants, shorts, or skort
- 3 4 pairs of seasonally-appropriate socks please see following pages
- 2 pairs of underwear

These Items do not need labelled:

4X6 photo of child's family - no framed photos, please

Letter from parents - see "Your Assignment" following

1 - 12-pack of Crayola colored pencils - 12 colors/pack only, please

1 package of 12 yellow Ticonderoga #2 pencils

1 wide-ruled plain Blue composition book, 100 sheets, with blue solid color cover - no spirals,

characters, or designs (standard size - 9 ¾ in x 7 ½ in) (For Language)

1 graph paper-ruled composition book, 100 sheets - no spirals, characters, or designs(standard size 9 $\frac{34}{10}$ in x 7 $\frac{12}{10}$ in) (For Math)

1 pack of wide rule notebook paper, 500 sheets

1 ream of white copy paper

1st Year Students

Gardening gloves - please write your child's initials on the cuff of each glove
1 pack of construction paper (multi-colored)
1 wide ruled plain red composition book- 100 sheets, with red solid color cover - no spirals, characters, or designs please (standard size - 9 ¾ in x 7 ½ in)
1- 10 count pack of BROAD LINE Classic Crayola markers (the fat, bulky ones)
1 pack of FINE TIP dry erase markers
1 pack of multi-colored tissue paper

2nd Year Students

1-10 pack FINE LINE Classic Crayola markers

1 wide ruled plain red composition book- 100 sheets, with red solid color cover – no spirals, characters, or designs please (standard size - 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ in x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ in)

1 pack of white cardstock

1 pack of dry erase markers

3rd Year Students

New Students to Amare for this year please also bring:

1 red composition book- 100 sheets, with solid color cover - no spirals, characters, or designs please (standard size - 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ in x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ in) Gardening gloves- please write your child's initials on the cuff of each glove.

Socks for the Seasons - Information

To ensure comfort when wearing rain boots on wet days, all lower elementary students will need 2 different kinds of socks for the season we experience during the school year. These may be included in your child's change of clothes bag.

- lightweight cotton socks for warmer months
- tall, thick, calf- or knee-length wool or wool-blend socks for colder months.

Although it will be several months before your child will need socks for cold, wintry weather, we advise you to please plan and order at least 3 – 5 pairs of tall, thick, calf- or knee-length wool or wool-blend socks for the colder months which are before us. Our rain boots will be used almost daily during the winter and boot-liners and good heavy socks are a must for staying warm.
