

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 45
 REGULATING THE HOURS FOR THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF
 INTOXICATING LIQUOR AND PROVIDING A PENALTY,
 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 54

The City Council of the City of New Munich, Minnesota, ordains:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 45 entitled "An Ordinance Licensing and Regulating the Sale and Consumption of Intoxicating Liquor, Repealing In-consistent Ordinances, and Providing a Penalty for Violation Thereof", is hereby amended by adding the following subdivision to Section 2.
 LICENSE REQUIRED:

Subdivision 4. Special License for Sunday Sales. A special license authorizing sales on Sunday in conjunction with the service of food may be issued to any hotel, restaurant or club, which has an "on-sale" license. All Sunday sales of liquor by such establishments shall only be made between the hours of 12:00 noon and 1 a.m. Monday.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 45 entitled "An Ordinance Licensing and Regulating the Sale and Consumption of Intoxicating Liquor, Repealing In-consistent Ordinances, and Providing a Penalty for Violation Thereof", is hereby amended by amendment of Section 12 as follows:

SECTION 12. PENALTY

Any person violating any provisions of this ordinance including the provisions of Chapter 340, Minnesota Statutes, which have been adopted by reference, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$700.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than ninety (90) days, plus costs of prosecution in either case.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 54 entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 45 Regulating the Hours for the Sale and Consumption of Intoxicating Liquor and Providing a Penalty" is hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
