

Update from the President:

January 11, 2021

Fellow Shareholders,

I understand that most of you are fearful and uneasy about the virus and not being able to receive the vaccine in an expeditious manner. Senior citizens all over the country and the world are experiencing the same thing. I do want you to know that your Park Manager, Jean Cobb and myself have called the Pasco County Health Department. I just got off the phone with them at 11:00 this morning.

Pasco County Health Department advised me they are out of the vaccine. They also said their instructions are to distribute first to the Nursing Homes and Assisted Living. They said they would call us as soon as they have more vaccine and they have fulfilled their obligation to the Nursing Homes and Assisted Living facilities. I would encourage anyone that can schedule with Publix or do the first come first serve method that Jean Cobb did to continue that path if you want the shot right away. Pasco County Health Department could not predict a timeframe when it would be available to us, only that they have our number and will call us.

In the meantime, I am receiving calls that some of the outdoor sports are not following the COVID guidelines. They report we have more than 10 in a group, that those groups are not distancing or wearing their masks. We also have reports that those using the pavilions even in smaller groups are not distancing or wearing their masks and are doing physical activities. We encourage and requested that anyone up doing any physical activity wear their mask and stay 6 ft. apart. People are not adhering to the post office rule of **one** in the post office at a time and some are not wearing their masks. If everyone is concerned about contracting the virus and wanting the shot then everyone should be diligent about following simple safety rules.

I would like nothing better than everyone to be able to participate in the activities that they enjoy. I'm sure you have heard the Living Bible translation, or your parent's have said, "Idle hands are the devil's workshop; idle lips are his mouthpiece." People are watching one another closely to see if they are following the safety guidelines. Please follow the rules and be kind to one another by respecting each other's potential health conditions. If people can't follow basic health and safety guidelines then the Park will have no choice than to lock down all activities indoor and out. That is not something we want to do. We want nothing more than to say Travelers Rest Resort only had a few cases and NO DEATHS in the park from COVID-19. Only you can make that happen.

I know I have made this statement before, but it is worth repeating. We have been advised by our law firm that under no circumstances can the Park or one of it's representatives release the name of anyone infected with COVID. The individual can tell anyone they want, but anyone representing the Park cannot. Please do not ask!
