The packet is made available so anyone interested in competing will know the requirements of this pageant process and the obligations of the Titleholders. The decision to participate in the Tucson Pride Pageant should require careful thought and consideration from each contestant. All contestants must exhibit a dedication to the organization and understand the hard work involved. Titleholders will have to volunteer and commit to preparation time for all attended events. Further, you must be willing to travel out-of-town. During your reign you will have the opportunity; in interviews and special events, to educate others and bring a higher level of awareness to the needs of the gay, lesbian, bisexual and transgender community. Those interested in competing for a pageant title must read the entire pageant packet. Please direct any questions you might have to the Tucson Pride Board. As a contestant, you will receive a free pageant weekend package.

Mr. and Miss Tucson Pride will be the contestant whose overall scores in the Talent, Creative Evening Wear, On-Stage question, Personal interview, and Fundraising are the highest average cumulative scoring system. Our judges are looking for a talented individual who has the ability to communicate to out LGBT community. If you fit the pattern, in what you have chosen for your presentations, you will score well. You will be evaluated for the duration of the pageant ONLY. However, if you are crowned you will abide by the rules and regulations set for by The Promoter and Tucson Pride Board.

The final placement score sheet will be available to contestants after the pageant has concluded. Each contestant will be given an opportunity to speak with the judge's panel, following the coronation of Mr. & Miss Tucson Pride 2017

Titleholder Rules and Regulations

In association with Mr. and Miss Tucson Pride 2017, Titleholders must abide by the Rules and Regulations, please be aware you are representing the Tucson community and Tucson Pride as a whole, titleholders must:

- Present themselves professionally while representing their perspective titles at all times
- Never demean the pageant or title they represent
- Never cause substantial problems for their promoters or for those whom they perform
- Never become OVERLY intoxicated while representing their respective title
- Never participate in any type of argument (except as a mediator) while representing their title
- Try to solve any problems with their promoter's and/or co-performers in a peaceful manner and in good faith.
- Never lecture the audience, only provide quality entertainment
- Violating the Code of Ethics for the Titleholders may result in the disqualification of the title and/or jeopardize the winner's or 1st alternates standing with "The House of Steel Production" and Tucson Pride
- **All contestants must be a resident of Arizona for the entire reigning year. Proof of Residency must be provided when applying. Acceptable forms of identification are: Valid Arizona Driver's License or ID card, school ID, passport or any photo identification issued by the State of Arizona.**
