Leadership Team (Ad Board) Report....

The Leadership Team meeting of January 15, 2019 was the first to be conducted in the new Simplified Accountability Structure format. Opening prayers and devotions were followed by a period of discussion based on the introduction and first chapter of the leadership training book entitled "The Necessary Nine" by Bob Farr and Kay Kotan. The meeting then progressed into brief examinations of the latest church financial reports, and we exchanged such committee reports as we had on hand. Following new business, the meeting ended with prayer.

We are contemplating the arrangement of fresh meetings with the agents of Hudock Moyer and Prudential, the two investment firms with which we work as a church. The aim is to get updates on the performances and trends of our portfolios and discuss possible optimizing adjustments.

Suncom has been contacted about the possibility of providing us with janitorial services in the church and Parish House. Outside volunteers have been enlisted to take care of snow removal.

Bethany will conduct the March 27, 2019 session of Soup and the Word. That will be the fourth of the six Wednesdays in Lent.

We are considering a revival of our Stephen Ministry program, which was successfully launched at Bethany a couple of years ago but never fully implemented.

Dates have been set for the rest of calendar 2019 for Bethany to serve Harvest Meals at St. Andrew's UMC. The full schedule will be published shortly.

Trustees Report....

As required by the Conference, we recently completed the annual Church Trustee's Report. The report includes the appraised value of the church building, Parish House, and parsonage. In addition, it includes questions about owned cemeteries, and if the church operates a day care or school. One key component of the report is the value of the funds entrusted to the Trustees. At the end of 2017 the total balance of all accounts was \$1,581,585, while we ended 2018 with \$1,390,605, a decrease of almost \$190,000. Over half the decrease was due to withdrawals for the new doors and current expense obligations. During 2018 we withdrew \$100,000 from the investments. We also closed three smaller accounts with a total balance of over \$14,000 and deposited those funds in the Current Expense Account. As many of you know, toward the end of the year, the stock market was pretty volatile. The difference between what we withdrew and the closed accounts can be attributed to our loss on investments.

The value of all church assets (property, furnishings, equipment, and investments) at the end of 2018 was \$8,196,206. We also report a value of \$340,000 for the parsonage and the church owned contents and equipment. The full report will be included in the Church Conference materials toward the end of the year. If you'd like a copy earlier, please ask Pastor Bill, Jamie or Cheri.


