Exhibition Dates: January 15 through May 10, 2020. (two floors of exhibition space)

Gallery Hours: Wednesday through Saturday, 10am to 4pm and Sunday, 12pm to 4pm.

Artists' Receptions: Saturday, January 18, 2 - 4pm and Friday, April 24, 6 - 8pm. Select artists could be featured speakers at each reception. Programming could include one or more artist demo workshop(s) sometime during exhibition run. Space restrictions will be taken into consideration.

Dates for delivery of artwork: Wed. through Fri., January 8-10, 10am - 4pm, & Saturday, January 11, 10am - 1pm.

Dates for pickup of artwork: Monday and Tuesday, May 11 - 12, 10am - 4pm and Saturday, May 16, 10am - 1pm.

Artists should pre-register with LMA on its website with artwork titles, medium, finished or **framed** dimensions of artwork, and comments about how their artwork relates to the theme (a few sentences or a short paragraph for inclusion on gallery label). Artwork should not have been publicly displayed previously within 15 miles of Cedarburg. All framed artwork or sculpture is not to exceed 40" in any direction and 2D work needs to be presented with D-rings or picture wire for hanging. Only works that are pre-registered will be accepted on drop-off dates. Artists may pre-register up to two (2) artworks each, but the second work may be subject to non-acceptance based on space availability and order of registration. If each of an artist's work does not exceed 16x20", s/he could submit up to three (3) works total if all works are in this smaller size range.

Registration deadline: November 30, 2019. Decisions on space availability for registered entries will be made by CAM curator and LMA exhibition chair 5 - 7 days after the registration deadline, based upon the order of entry receipt.

Artwork can be for sale or Not for Sale (NFS). If work is not for sale, please state a verifiable insurance value on the Entry Form. Sales are encouraged. The Cedarburg Art Museum retains 35% of any sales. Artists will fill out a CAM Consignment Form if work is for sale, or CAM Loan Form if NFS and turn it in at the time of delivery. Forms can be sent electronically to LMA artists in advance or available as a PDF form on LMA website.

After the Cedarburg Art Museum receives LMA artwork, it will be insured by the Museum while it is on Museum premises.
