The Town Council will be meeting on May 23rd at 6:00 pm to tour the new Wastewater Treatment Plant. After the tour, they will convene at approximately 7:00 at the Town Hall to discuss options for repayment of the construction loan, and to talk about other necessary improvements. Council would like to invite all the residents and property owners to join in the tour and in the discussion that follows. There are some major decisions to be made, & your input & understanding is extremely important. Parking is limited at the lagoon site, so please meet at Town Hall and we will carpool to the facility.

The facility accepts clean, green materials suitable for composting such as; lawn clippings, leaves, garden waste and limbs.

The facility does not accept; processed wood, household waste, animal waste, or kitchen waste.

The facility is open to anyone in the Southeast Spokane County and the following fees apply;

\$6.00 Minimum for any materials ½ yard or less. \$12.00 per yard or any materials over ½ a yard. No Commercial Haulers

Please be aware that burning for any purpose other than a recreational fire pit is not allowed in Rockford Town limits at any time. This is a regulation imposed by the Spokane Regional Clean Air Agency.
