

### eTranscript CA 2.0: Electronic Transcripts

- Transcript exchange provided by the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO) since 2007
- Exchanging transcripts in the California Electronic Transcript Standard between CCC, CSU, UC systems (and private colleges)
- 102 Institutions are registered with the service
- Upgrade of system architecture planned leveraging
  - CCC SuperGlue
  - EdExchange



# eTranscript CA 2.0: Leveraging EdExchange

- Neutral platform for data and digital documents.
- Developed by the California Community Colleges Technology Center, operated by the Postsecondary Electronic Standards Council (PESC), including partners such as National Student Clearinghouse, & Parchment
- Open web services model securely transmits files real time directly between colleges and proprietary exchanges
- Payload agnostic, supporting a multitude of document types
- May be used to extend eTranscript CA to all postsecondary institutions in the state and compatible with CCGI's platform



#### eTranscript CA 2.0: Beyond Transcripts

- Extend platform to deliver other forms of learning documentation
- Integrate workflow and privacy controls that enable learner permission to share information with colleges and employers
- Connect with a new system under development by the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) to share, with consent, confirmation of specific statuses
- Opportunity to enable master data management that supports data quality policy and technology support throughout the system



# California College Guidance Initiative (CCGI)

- Manages CaliforniaColleges.edu, the State's college and career guidance platform for 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students
  - 1 in 5 California 6-12<sup>th</sup> grade students has a transcript-informed account
  - More than half of school counselors in K12 have accounts on the system
- Feeds into seamless application integrations with CCCApply, Cal State Apply, and the California Student Aid Commission, which enables:
  - 100% match rate on identifiers across systems
  - Student approval of the data that gets shared with receiving institutions
  - Data informed decisions about admissions, placement, guidance, financial aid and supportive services, based on the most timely and accurate data available




# CA Department of Social Services (CDSS)


- CDSS is responsible for the oversight and administration of programs serving California's most vulnerable children and adults.
- CDSS systems contain information regarding eligibility and receipt of CDSSadministered benefits and services.
- With the individual's consent, CDSS can pull this information from these systems and then provide the information to EdExchange through an API.
- Identifying the benefits and services received by these individuals can give others the information needed to provide these individuals additional assistance.
- The two main systems from which CDSS will be able to pull the data are the California Statewide Automated Welfare System (CalSAWS) and the Child Welfare Services / Case Management System (CWS/CMS). Both of these systems are currently being upgraded.







