## MEMORIAL DAY

Memorial Day is almost upon us. Monday, 31 May 2021. Came on quickly, didn't it? On behalf of Anderson-Claffy Post 109, American Legion, I offer the following Memorial Day information:

Volunteers will place grave marker flags at Lake View Cemetery in Two Harbors on Friday, 28 May starting at approximately 0830. If you know of a veteran buried outside the veterans section (with a civilian or family marker), let someone know so the flag crew won't miss them. Each year some are missed; it's inevitable. Contact other cemeteries or townships if looking for flag posting info at greater Lake County locations. Volunteers may also beautify areas as needed.

No public programs are scheduled, still due to COVID-19 protocols. In Two Harbors, Unit 109, American Legion Auxiliary, and VFW 137 Auxiliary, along with the American Legion Honor Guard, will place flower petals at the Edna G. boat dock at 1100 in memory of Navy, Marine, Coast Guard, and Merchant Marine personnel, then move to Lake View Cemetery, Veterans Section, at 1200 for military honors with the U.S. Flag raised to full-staff. At 1300, there is a memorial dedication and military honors conducted at the Knife River Depot.

Memorial Day reminds us of our solemn duty to remember U.S. service personnel killed in action or in service, and also to remember the bereaved GOLD STAR families left behind. Let's not forget those wounded soldiers, either, but the day is first and foremost for remembrance of our fallen. Some suggestions for Memorial Day:

- Visit and /or clean cemeteries or memorials.
- Place a flag or floral arrangement on graves of soldiers.
- Display the American Flag at half-staff until noon. Include the POW/MIA flag, if possible.
- Make a pledge to aid survivors and disabled veterans, AND KEEP IT.
- Pray, if so inclined, for the souls of our fallen, and their families to find peace. Meditate over the fact that lives were lost in service to our country...blood was shed to preserve our way of life. It's the right thing to do.
- Finally, consider joining and becoming active in a veteran service organization, and an Honor Guard.


