

FORMAT FOR 2026 will be the same as last year:

1. Cutting and Reined Cow Horse will take place on June 4, 5 & 6 (Thursday, Friday & Saturday) with check-in on Wednesday, June 3rd from 10AM to 3PM;
2. Check-in for all other contestants will be Sunday, June 7th from 9AM to 12PM;
3. All barrier events (SW, TD, BAW & TR) will run both go rounds on whatever day they draw up;
4. Bareback & Saddle Bronc will only buck during the afternoon performances. If a contestant draws up on Monday, they will ride their 2nd horse on Wednesday. If they draw up on Tuesday, they will ride their 2nd horse on Thursday; and,
5. Bull Riding will have split performances as follows:
 - a. Monday morning - Wednesday afternoon
 - b. Monday afternoon - Thursday morning
 - c. Tuesday morning - Thursday afternoon
 - d. Tuesday afternoon - Friday morning
 - e. Wednesday morning - Friday afternoon
6. Barrels will have 25 contestants in each performance and will have split performances as follows:
 - a. Monday morning - Friday afternoon
 - b. Monday afternoon - Friday morning
 - c. Tuesday morning - Thursday afternoon
 - d. Tuesday afternoon - Thursday morning

These must be ordered at the last region rodeo as well

STALLS - stalls are \$140 per stall – you may have one stall for every event you are entered in that require a horse. Steer Wrestlers, Girls Cutting and Boys Cutting entries are allowed 2 stalls at regular price of \$140. (Rough stock events along with shooting events do not require a stall and will be considered an extra stall if ordered.)

EXTRA STALLS – the extra stalls you may need will be \$250 each

STUD STALLS – stud stalls will be \$150 each

NO TACK STALLS ARE ALLOWED

SHAVINGS – shavings can be ordered when you enter or onsite - \$10 a bag

VIDEO FEE – this is a mandatory fee for cutters and reiners - \$25 per event. This is for judges to be able to review runs if needed

RV – all finalists that request a hookup will receive a hookup. There are limited 50 amp spots and 30 amp FULL spots but plenty of 30 amp water/electricity. RV spots are \$165

ADULT SEASON PASS- this is a presale armband – they are \$60 each and the armbands will be at your region table for pick up. If you do not purchase online, you can buy at the event

CHILD SEASON PASS- this is a presale armband – they are \$40 each and the armbands will be at your region table for pick up – these are for children that are enrolled in school (kindergarten through high school). If you do not purchase online, you can buy at the event

STALL MATS - these may be pre-purchased – see flyer in package – she will also be on the grounds to sell. Cost is \$365 per mat and this includes installation.

The State E Board unexpectedly increased High School State entry fees in the middle of the season from \$200 to \$300. Region X could not budget for this increase in the middle of the season. The Region will still be reimbursing high school contestants for the \$200 per entry fee and you will be responsible for the \$100 difference.

All State Entries must be made online and paid before you leave the last rodeo March 8th.

Ground Rules At The 2026 THSRA STATE FINALS - Abilene, Texas -
June 4 - 13, 2026

- 1) All contestants must bring either their final report card for the 2025-26 school year, transcript for the 2025-26 school year, or a letter from their school (on school stationary, with school seal) listing their Spring Semester Grades or a letter stating that the contestant has passed at least 70% of subjects taken for the 2nd semester (not year end grades). The letter must be signed by a school counselor, principal or superintendent. **NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO CHECK IN WITHOUT ONE OF THESE DOCUMENTS. NO ONE WILL BE ABLE TO HAVE GRADES FAXED AFTER 1:00 PM SUNDAY, JUNE 7th - this will be when check-in is over.**
- 2) Any contestant having a problem making the check-in time on Sunday, June 7th, needs to call this office (936)590-4447 ASAP. The only excuse for being late to check-in has to be school related.
- 3) Campers and/or horses cannot be brought in and left on grounds or in stalls before **Wednesday morning, June 3rd, 2026, starting at 8:00 AM for the cutting and Reined Cow Horse** contestants or Friday, June 5th, 2026, for the remaining finals' contestants. Gates will close at 5:00 PM on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Starting at 7:00 AM Saturday morning, gates will be open 24/7. As contestants arrive, they will be directed to their assigned stalls and shown where to park his/her trailer or camper by Expo personnel and Taylor County officials. Any contestant refusing to park where shown or any contestant that tries to move once parked, will be asked to leave the premises immediately and will not be allowed to park their living quarters trailer and/or non living quarters trailer on the grounds.
- 4) All non living quarter trailers will be parked in the area designated by Expo personnel.
- 5) Any contestant planning to stay on the grounds must bring their own water hoses and extension cords for trailers, and contestants with horses must bring their own fans, extension cords for fans, and water hoses.
- 6) Each contestant staying on grounds will be issued one (1) parking pass. Contestants with living quarters in RV#s 1-38, 200-269 & 401-604 may purchase a 2nd pass for \$50.00. Only vehicles with a parking pass will be allowed on the grounds. There will be no more than two (2) passes issued per contestant. Any other vehicles will be parked in the public parking areas and use the walk thru gates. **Contestants/family members staying off premises do not have the privilege of purchasing any additional passes.**
- 7) Dress Code
 - A. Inside Taylor Telecom Arena - full dress (hats, boots, long sleeves, and back #s on back)
 - B. First Financial Bank Pavilion - full dress sitting in the stands and while competing. While in the stall area of horse barn, back # must be on back.
- 8) Alcohol and Drugs
 - A. No tolerance for alcohol consumption and/or drugs or in presence of alcohol and/or drugs.
 - B. Automatic trip home.
- 9) Cruising Around in Vehicles
 - A. There is to be NO cruising around in automobiles or trucks. Golf carts are available for rent.
 - B. You **MUST** be a licensed driver to order a golf cart and only licensed drivers are

allowed to drive the golf carts. EVERYONE must adhere to the passenger capacity of the golf cart you rent!!!!

C. Speed limit signs will be posted and must be complied with.

10) Non-Licensed Vehicles

11) RV Spaces

No vehicle may park in areas where RV hookups are located. All RV spaces will be assigned prior to contestant arrival. If you want to be parked by someone in particular, please let your region secretary know so she can send in with the state entry worksheet. Again, anyone caught moving their trailer and/or camper once parked by Expo personnel may be asked to leave the premises.

12) Electrical Panels

No contestant and/or family member should attempt to work on any electrical panel on the facility. Should problems arise, please notify the main office or rodeo secretary, and a licensed electrician will take care of any issue. If this is not adhered to, you will be asked to leave the grounds with your RV and/or horse.

13) RV Hookups

All RV hookups at the Expo Center are GFI compatible. If your trailer plug is not GFI (ground fault) compatible, you may have to contact an RV repairman to correct the plug prior to being able to get power at the Expo Center,





